- 100% of parents and students believe this is a good school.


Our initiatives include

- Engaging a specialist Science, Technology, Engineering & Mathematics (STEM) teacher for P-3 students.
- Appointing a Head of Teaching Innovation and Performance (HoTIP) to lead innovative teaching practice and track and measure school performance.
- Improving the learning outcomes of our Special Education Program (SEP) students through intensive teaching and collaboration with specialist staff to facilitate intensive support programs.
- Supporting the learning goals of our English as an Additional Language/Dialect (EAL/D) students.
