
Home-grown talent includes local niche providers in the banking, insurance and telemarketing fields: Ant Marketing, DDC Outsourcing, Direct Group, Parseq, and Voice Marketing.

Private service sector companies employ nearly 421,000 people (45.5%) in Sheffield within the one hour peak journey to work catchment. The financial and business service sector is one of the largest sectors in the area, employing 12.7 per cent of the workforce (117,100 people).

Shared service centres are a hidden employer. Besides business service companies there are a wealth of centres amongst our manufacturing community.

- 18,900 people have banking and finance skills. HSBC is one of the largest private sector employers in the city, employing over 4,500 people. DLA Piper, BOC and Insight all have European finance shared service centres in the city
- Over 7,000 accountants are registered with professional bodies
- 13,400 people work in IT support and development. HSBC's global IT shared service centre employs 2,000 people in Sheffield
- Legal activities employ 8,600 people. Irwin Mitchell have bulk process conveyancing facilities at their headquarters in the city
- Insurance accounts for 7,700 employees, including life, pensions administration and employee benefits. Aviva employs 1,800 people in the city
- Royal Mail employ over 300 staff in Europe's largest HR shared service centre in the city
- Capita also have HR, finance and IT shared service centres amongst their 8,300 staff in the City Region

Sheffield has developed a vibrant commercial environment in which business and financial services operations can thrive. This makes the city region the location of choice for a variety of recognised brand BPO providers, contact centres and shared service centres.
