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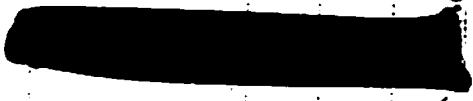
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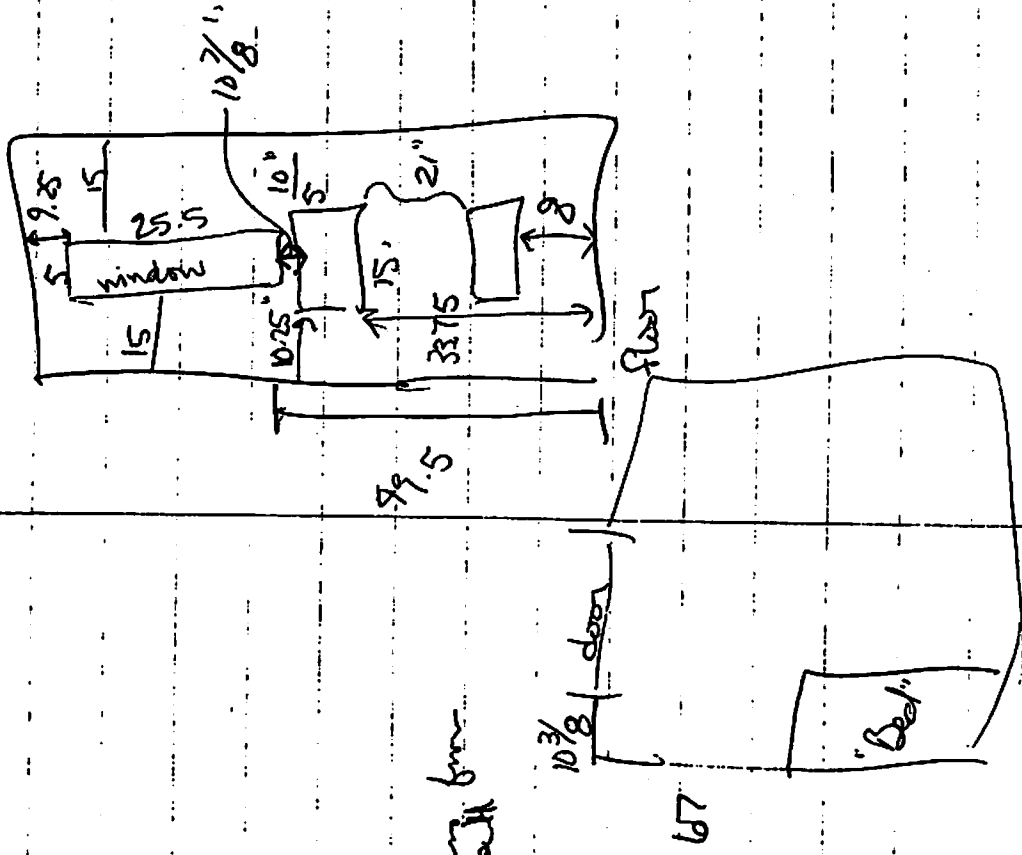

(FOUO) ██████████ RELATED THAT SHE SPED ALL THE WAY TO BHU, AND UPON ARRIVAL, CIRCA 1024 HOURS, SHE OBSERVED A COUPLE OF CORPSMAN ADMINISTERING CPR TO V/AL HANASHI, WHO WAS STRAPPED TO A BACKBOARD AND LAY ON THE FLOOR. ██████████ ADVISED THAT V/AL HANASHI WAS PARTIALLY OUT OF HIS CELL; THAT HIS UPPER BODY LAID ON THE TIER AND HIS LOWER BODY WAS STILL INSIDE OF HIS CELL. ██████████ RELATED THAT NURSE ██████████ WAS OPERATING THE AUTOMATED EXTERNAL DEFIBRILLATION MACHINE AND THAT AN UNIDENTIFIED BLACK FEMALE WAS OPERATING THE BAG VALVE MASK - PROVIDING AIR TO V/AL HANASHI.

(FOUO) ██████████ STATED THAT SHE IMMEDIATELY CALLED FOR SUCTION BECAUSE SHE COULD SEE A LOT OF VOMIT ON THE FLOOR NEAR AND AROUND V/AL HANASHI. ██████████ ADVISED THAT SHE WAS INFORMED BY ██████████ THAT THEY ALREADY PERFORMED SUCTION (AN ATTEMPT TO REMOVE VOMIT FROM V/AL HANASHI'S AIRWAY), BUT THEY DID IT AGAIN - PER HER ORDER. ██████████ ADVISED THAT V/AL HANASHI WAS TURNED ON HIS SIDE, AS THIS AIDS THE SUCTION PROCESS. ██████████ ADVISED THAT PATIENTS OFTEN VOMIT WHEN CPR IS BEING PERFORMED, SO ALL THE VOMIT SHE HAD OBSERVED WAS IN HER OPINION, COMPLETELY NORMAL. ██████████ ADVISED THAT A CORPSMAN (NFI) WAS CHECKING V/AL HANASHI FOR A PULSE AND THAT SHE BORROWED THE CORPSMAN'S FLASHLIGHT AND CHECKED V/AL HANASHI'S PUPILS - WHICH SHE STATED, WERE UNRESPONSIVE.

(██████) ██████ ADVISED THAT WHEN V/AL HANASHI ARRIVED, THE DIVO WAS PERFORMING CPR AND THAT THE UNIDENTIFIED BLACK FEMALE CONTINUED TO OPERATE THE BAG VALVE MASK. ██████ ADVISED THAT AN IV WAS ATTEMPTING TO BE INSERTED INTO ONE OF V/AL HANASHI'S ARMS AND THE BAG VALVE MASK HAD BEEN HOOKED UP TO THE OXYGEN LINE. VENTURA ADVISED THAT ALL OF THESE THINGS WERE HAPPENING SIMULTANEOUSLY - SHE ORDERED FOR SUCTION TO BE PERFORMED AGAIN AND THAT AN ORAL AIRWAY WAS INSERTED TO HELP OPEN UP V/AL HANASHI'S AIRWAY.

11. (██████) VENTURA ADVISED THAT THE "C" COLLAR AROUND V/AL HANASHI'S NECK WAS TAKEN OFF AND A #7.0 INDO TRACHEAL TUBE WAS INSERTED DOWN HIS THROAT. SHE STATED THAT SHE PUT AN IV BAG BEHIND HIS NECK TO HELP KEEP THE AIRWAY OPEN. ██████ STATED SHE USED WHAT IS REFERRED TO AS A 'BLADE' - PART OF THE INTUBATION PROCESS TO HELP SEE IF YOU ARE INSERTING THE TUBE CORRECTLY. ██████ STATED THEY LISTENED FOR BREATH SOUNDS UTILIZING A STETHOSCOPE AND WERE ABLE TO VERIFY THAT THE TUBE HAD BEEN INSERTED PROPERLY. ██████ STATED THAT THE BREATH SOUNDS WERE COMING FROM THE BAG VALVE MASK AND THAT V/AL HANASHI WAS NOT SPONTANEOUSLY BREATHING ON HIS OWN. ██████ ADVISED THAT SHE COULD HEAR WAS SHE DESCRIBED AS "CRACKLES," COMING FROM THE RIGHT LUNG, WHICH MEANS THAT VOMIT IS PRESENT IN THE LUNGS. SHE STATED THAT SHE PERFORMED IN-LINE SUCTION ON V/AL HANASHI, AND THAT THEY WERE ABLE TO CLEAR OUT A LOT OF THE VOMIT. ██████ ADVISED THAT A CORPSMAN ADMINISTERED A DOSE OF EPINEPHRINE TO V/AL HANASHI, POSSIBLY IN HIS RIGHT THIGH. ██████ ADVISED THAT SHE WAS NOT AWARE OF THE EXACT DOSING; HOWEVER, IT WAS THE STANDARD DOSE

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STOCKED IN THE CRASH CART. ██████████ ADVISED THAT A SECOND DOSE OF EPINEPHRINE WAS ADMINISTERED THROUGH THE IV, AND ALSO A DOSE OF ATROPINE IN AN ATTEMPT TO BOOST A HEART RATE (IF FAINTLY PRESENT). ██████████ ADVISED AFTER A COUPLE OF MINUTES THE DIVO STOPPED CPR AND EVERYONE LOOKED AT THE MONITOR, WHICH DISPLAYED NO RHYTHMIC ACTIVITY. ██████████ ADVISED THAT SHE CHECKED V/AL HANASHI'S PUPILS AGAIN AND THEY WERE STILL FIXED AND DILATED. SHE STATED THAT SHE OBSERVED PETECHIAL HEMORRHAGES - TINY LITTLE BLOOD SPOTS IN THE WHITES OF THE EYES, WHICH IS CONSISTENT WITH CHOCKING OR LOSS OF AIRWAY. ██████████ ADVISED THAT SHE INFORMED EVERYONE THAT V/AL HANASHI LOOKED THE SAME AS HE DID WHEN SHE INITIALLY ARRIVED. ██████████ RELATED THAT ██████████ STATED, "HOW LONG HAVE WE BEEN WORKING ON THIS?" ██████████ STATED THEY HAD ALL DETERMINED THAT CPR ALONE HAD BEEN GIVEN FOR OVER ONE HALF HOUR AND UPON HEARING THAT, ██████████ CALLED THE CODE' - WHICH MEANS THAT IT'S TIME TO STOP LIFE SAVING MEASURES. ██████████ STATED THAT SHE BELIEVED THE TIME OF DEATH FOR V/AL HANASHI WAS 10:54 P.M.

12. (FOUO) ██████████ ADVISED THAT AFTER THE TIME OF DEATH WAS CALLED, SHE WENT BACK TO HER OFFICE AND BEGAN WRITING OUT HER NOTES OF THE EVENING'S EVENTS. SHE STATED SHE ALSO TALKED WITH ██████████ AND ██████████ ABOUT EVERYTHING THAT HAD JUST TRANSPIRED. ██████████ RELATED SHE LEFT THE HOSPITAL AROUND 0230 HOURS ON 02JUN09.

13. (FOUO) ██████████ ADVISED THAT WHEN SHE INITIALLY ARRIVED, THERE WERE A LOT OF GUARDS STANDING AROUND V/AL HANASHI, WHILE HE WAS ON THE FLOOR IN BHU. ██████████ RELATED THAT V/AL HANASHI'S HANDS AND FEET WERE ALREADY SECURED WITH ZIP TIES WHEN SHE ARRIVED. SHE STATED THAT SHE DID NOT SEE ANY BLOOD COMING FROM V/AL HANASHI'S NOSE OR MOUTH AS REPORTED EARLIER BY ██████████; JUST A LOT OF VOMIT.
