Outline Description	Residential House
Property Description	A two storey building, characterised by a very plain austere façade which is only pierced by two slit windows at the upper floor. The entrance at ground floor level is through a remissa doorway above which is an open balcony supported by a large single plain moulded corbel. The balcony is set within a three centred archway supported on heavy imposts. A niche is centrally placed on top of the balcony's archway. This building was used as the headquarters of Vincenzo Borg during the French blockade of 1799 and was the first building to hoist the British Flag on the Island.
