LMRC COMMISSIONS TRAIN AUTOMATIC WASHING PLANT AT THE TRANSPORT NAGAR METRO DEPOT



Lucknow Metro successfully commissioned the Automatic Train Washing Plant at the Transport Nagar Metro Depot on 28th April, 2017. Through this facility, the Metro trains entering or exiting the Depot can be cleaned automatically at the ramp using remote control from the Operation Control Centre (OCC) located inside the Depot.

It is planned in such a manner that the trains can be washed once in three day. The plant operation starts automatically by sensing the train speed. The minimum washing capacity of plant is 25 trains per day which can be increased based on future requirements. To avoid excessive use of water, the facility of recycling of the water for reuse has been commissioned additionally.




LUCKNOW METRO ACHIEVES MILESTONE IN UNDERGROUND TUNNELING WORK; TBM'GOMTI'REACHES HAZRATGANJ

On 7th May, 2017, Lucknow Metro achieved a major milestone in underground Metro as the Tunnel Boring Machine (TBM) 'Gomti' reached below the Mahatma Gandhi (MG) Marg in Hazratganj, thereby, excavating a tunnel of 732 meters in just four months.

The tunneling work for the 3.67 km long underground section (UP Line) of Lucknow Metro Phase 1A Project continues to progress at an extremely fast pace. The total length of the 5.8m dia tunnel from Sachivalaya underground Metro station to Hazratganj underground Metro station is 811m.

The second TBM 'Ganga' is working simultaneously for the DOWN Line and it has also completed a tunneling of about 190 m as on 7th May, 2017. The state-of-the-art



onboard computerized tunnel tunneling is done as per the designed alignment. Extensive instrumentation has been done

throughout the underground stretch guidance system ensures that and continuous online and real time monitoring is done by a team of dedicated experts to ensure safety during the TBM operation.
