Competition Format and Rules

As of WED 09 OCT 2018

Youth Olympic Competition Format

The Roller Speed Skating competition at the Summer Youth Olympic Games Buenos Aires 2018 will comprise two events, Men's Combined and Women's Combined, with fourteen skaters in each event. The event consists of three distances (phases); 500m Sprint, 1000m Sprint and 5000m Elimination. All skaters compete in all distances. Skaters will be ranked by points scored in all three distances.

Differences between the Roller Speed Skating Junior World Championships and the Summer Youth Olympic Games

Each event takes place separately at the Junior World Championships and as one combined event at the YOG.

There are more events at the Junior World Championships, including five individual events and one relay event for each gender.

There are both road and track events at the Junior World Championships, but only track events at the YOG.

Changes since the Summer Youth Olympic Games Nanjing 2014

Roller Speed Skating is on the programme for the first time in Buenos Aires 2018.

Sport Rules and Procedures

The track is 200 metres long.

Races will be timed automatically, with an accuracy of one thousandth of a second.

Skaters compete in heats (sprint) or start together (elimination). The starting order for each distance is established by The WSK.

500m Sprint: There will be three Rounds; Quarterfinals (two heats with four skaters and two heats with three skaters), Semifinals (two heats with four skaters) and Final (four skaters). The first two skaters from each heat progress to the next round.

1000m Sprint: There will be two Rounds; Semifinals (two heats with seven skaters) and Final (eight skaters). The first place from each heat and the six best times qualify for the Final.

5000m Elimination: All 14 skaters start, thereafter seven single eliminations every two laps (21, 19, 17, 15, 13, 11, 9, 7, 5, 3 and 1 laps to go). The remaining three skaters to complete the final sprint.

The event results are based on points. The winner of each distance is awarded 14 points, second place 13 points, third place 12 points, and the remaining places 4-14 are awarded from 11 points down to 1 point. In the 500m and 1000m Sprint points athletes are ranked by finishing position in the final, and then by times achieved in the last round completed (Semifinal or Quarterfinal). In the 5000m Elimination athletes are ranked by finishing position, and then by number of laps completed before elimination.

The final ranking of skaters is based on the total number of points earned in the three phases (higher points=higher rank).

Tie Break Rules

Distance:

- If two or more competitors are tied to the thousandth of a second, they will receive the same rank. If the tie is for a qualification place, all tied competitors will qualify for the next round. If the tie is for the final ranking within one of the three distances, all tied competitors will receive the number of points normally associated with the tied place (e.g. if two competitors are tied for 1st place in a distance, both will receive 14 points. The third placed competitor will receive 12 points as normal).

Event (only applicable after the 5000m Elimination):

- If two or more competitors are tied to the same number of points, the better place obtained in the 5000m Elimination will break the tie. If the competitors remain tied, they will share the same classification.



Penalties / Disqualification Rules

A breach of WSK competition rules is part of the normal competition and will either cause a reduced in rank ("RR") or disqualification ("DSQ"). If such a decision is taken, the concerned athlete may or may not be considered for placing in a phase or event.

Protests

- a) The Speed Technical Commission (STC) is the body of first instance for claims concerning the application of general STC regulations. Such claims must be different from Jury decisions about sanctions. Those Jury sanctions are final.
 1. STC evaluates if the claim proceeds and if it does STC will give an official answer
- b) Claims regarding the admittance of a skater to a competition may be submitted:
 1. by a Federation delegate who believes that one of his skaters has not been admitted though he was eligible
 2. by all Federations delegates believing to have been damaged because of the admittance to the competition of a skater belonging to another Federation, who does not have the right to participate
- c) Claims have to be signed by the official delegate and submitted in writing to the Chief Referee thirty minutes prior to the beginning of the race. When a referee believes he has adequate information to admit a skater to a competition, and that such an admittance is the subject of a dispute, he can admit said skater with due reservation, leaving the final decision to STC that will take care of any necessary.
- d) This decision must be made known to the official delegates of the participating countries
