



Alleged Ballot Harvesting in Georgia Statistical Analysis of Ballots Returned Versus Ballots Requested



- Ballot harvesting would result in either unusually high or low ballot return rate.
- Graph on the left is a logarithmic comparison of ballots requested versus ballots returned
- Statistical analysis of ballot return rates shows no anomalous points. No suspicious indicators of ballot harvesting.

- Thirty-eight addresses received more than 20 absentee ballots in Georgia.
- Each one was analyzed to determine if it could be a potential incident of ballot harvesting.
- All the addresses correlated with a location that could plausibly receive multiple ballots (See table above right).
- No potential incidents of ballot harvesting were discovered using this analytical method.



Conclusions

- Analysis of ballots requested versus ballots returned shows no statistical anomalies that would be associated with ballot harvesting
- Analysis of addresses receiving more than 20 absentee ballots shows addresses are multi-resident locations with the largest number (84) going to a college dormitory

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
