A PROCLAMATION. GEORGE R.

H.E.R.E.A.S certain evil-minded Perfons did, on the Morning of the Twentyeighth Day of July laft, fet Fire to the Out-Houfes of Mr. James Wheat, of Norwood-Hall, in Our County of York; We have thought fit, by and with the Advice of Our Privy Council, to publifh and declare Our Refolution that the Authors, Abettors and Perpetrators of the faid Offence be profecuted as fpeedily as may be, according to the due Courfe of Law : And We do hereby enjoin and require all Juftices of the Peace, Sheriffs, Mayors, Bailiffs, Conftables, and all Our loving Subjects, to

be aiding and affifting, to the utmost of their Power, in detecting, apprehending and bringing to Justice the faid Offenders: And We are graciously pleased to promife, that if any Person shall discover any other Person or Persons who were guilty of the faid Offence, so as the Person or Persons discovered may be profecuted for the fame, fuch Discoverer shall have as a Reward ONE HUNDRED POUNDS for each and every such Offender, and also Our gracious Pardon for the faid-Offence, in case the Person making such Discovery shall himself be liable to be profecuted for fame.
