Dear Colleagues:

The University of Washington had another record-breaking year with sponsored research funds totaling \$1.037 billion. Our commitment to research activities furthers the advancement of knowledge, provides support to our educational mission, and enhances research in the global community. The positive impacts of the UW's academic research to our regional economy cannot be overlooked as we consider the impacts of hiring faculty, staff and students; partnerships between research and industry; licensing of technology, and the formation of start-up companies.

The UW has experienced positive growth in external support of research. Since 1988, the UW has grown awards from \$289 million to \$1.037 billion in 2008. This is the second year in a row UW researchers have been awarded over a billion dollars in support for salaries, graduate and undergraduate student support, and infrastructure. Page 11 details the proposals prepared by UW faculty and staff requesting support. The current funding environment is fiercely competitive and the UW has been successful because of the quality of work, the world-class faculty and staff, and the support of its leadership.

A great research university must have correspondingly professional and effective support systems. This year, the Office of Research launched a unit-wide strategic and organizational improvement effort called Improving Service to Advance Research (iSTAR). We are working to transform our climate, processes, service, and the manner in which we interact with our process partners and key stakeholders. The outcome of these efforts is to greatly enhance and increase services to researchers and their support staff.

The level of excellence in research and scholarship at the UW reflects the strength of the University. With the economic challenges we are all facing, it is important to recognize that research conducted at the UW makes a difference, not only in our region but around the globe. The Office of Research continues to be a strong partner in the advancement of fundamental and translational research here at the University of Washington. I am excited about the opportunities for this year and I look forward to working with all of you in your efforts to make discoveries and change the world.



Preface

The impressive breadth of world class research, service and training programs at the University of Washington is reflected in the broad level of grant and contract funding it receives each year from external sources. This extramural funding is received by the University as a result of proposals developed by faculty members and professional staff and is awarded generally on a national, competitive, peer-reviewed basis. The award information and data represent only funds received by the UNIV for sponsored projects. Sponsored project awards are independent of funds received by the University through legislative appropriations for its core educational mission and independent of philanthropic gifts received from donors. However, the expenditure information provided does include philanthropic gifts and some research-specific direct appropriations from the state of Washington.

The awards received by the University of Washington support the broad range of public services, research and educational programs offered on campus. In turn, these programs enhance the quality of life for the citizens of the State of Washington, the nation and internationally. The chart below demonstrates the tremendous growth in the total dollar value of awards received annually since 1987. As can be seen the trajectory is upward and UW has quickly become one of the top universities in the country as measured by external awards received.

Trends

Over the past few years, the funds available to universities has diminished somewhat, making the UW growth in awards especially impressive. While the NIH budget for extramural awards increased and almost doubled early in this century, there have been significant cutbacks in discretionary funds available from most federal agencies. In the coming year it is still unknown what effect the economic downturn will have on research and other sponsored projects for universities.

For the UW, awards from foundations and non-profit organizations have increased by almost 30% in the last two years. Much of this increase can be attributed to the expansion of international support for critical health research and delivery. The Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation has provided strong support for UW programs and researchers.

Support for research from industry has remained static over the past two years. However, with new direction provided by campus leadership, the UW will open up new opportunities for partnership with regional and national industries.

Summary of Present Funding Sources

External funding for research, education and training and other academic and service programs at the University of Washington is derived from a broad spectrum of sources, including federal agencies, state agencies, local governmental units, private foundations, and business and industry. The total of Grant and Contract awards for Fiscal Year 2008 (FY08) amounted to \$1.037 billion.

Federal Support: By far the largest share of grant and contract support comes from Federal agencies. In FY08, awards totaling \$759.5 million or about 73% of total grant and contract awards, were received from federal agencies for support of research, equipment, fellowships and traineeships, special programs of instruction, and service program that support our region and the nation. This large share of federal support is consistent with the past several years. The ratio of federal funding to non-federal support provides a consistent base of funding support for campus and is slightly higher than the national norm. The largest sources of federal support during FY08 were the Department of Health and Human Services (\$506.1 million), the National Science Foundation (\$80.9 million), the Department of Education (\$44.5 million), and the Department of Defense (\$44 million). The total federal support is a \$33M decrease from FY07. This is in great measure due to the significant decrease in the overall federal support for research, especially in non-defense discretionary funds.

Non-Federal Support: Non-federal support for UW programs exceeded \$277.6M in FY08. This is an increase of \$51M over the FY 07 awards of \$226M. The largest increases came from foundations, such as the Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation, and from the State of Washington. A significant increase also came from private industry; FY 07 funding was \$33.8M and FY08 was \$37.2, an increase of a little over 10%. Over the past year, the UW has continued to expand its capacity for collaboration with industry to support the State's economic enhancement efforts.

Notes

The following notes and definitions may assist the reader in reviewing this report.

1. **Proposals:** The proposals submitted by the University on behalf of principal investigators or program directors are the official request for support. Proposals may be submitted to federal, state and other governmental agencies, not-for-profit foundations, private industry and business, and other academic institutions.

2. Awards: Awards are received by the University in response to proposals submitted by the faculty. Generally they are received either as grants or contracts and represent financial resources that have become available for covering the cost of research, service or education and training. Awards include grants for student scholarships, fellowships and work study programs administered by the Vice President for Student Affairs.

3. Expenditures: These represent completed financial transactions. Generally, the total grant and contract expenditures for a given fiscal year will be reasonably related to the total grant and contract awards for the preceding year or two. Total expenditures include both direct expenditures and indirect costs. The term *direct expenditures* as used throughout this report covers only those costs incurred in direct support of the specific project. *Indirect costs* or *Facilities and Administrative costs* are those incurred centrally by the University for the common benefit of academic departments and programs.

4. **International Support:** The majority of grant and contract awards support research programs and projects but, in addition, significant support is provided for training programs, fellowships, conferences and other special purposes. Of particular significance is the growth in the University's awards for international research and training. With the development of the Global Support Project, the UW has become the national leader in establishing the infrastructure necessary to carry out global projects. The Global Support Project and UWorld, the foundation established to enable UW to carry out significant programs in countries around the globe, have attained international recognition.

5. Centers and Institutes: The University has many departmental, interdepartmental, and interschool research centers and institutes. These entities assist the University in carrying out its teaching, research, and public service missions; they are especially valuable in facilitating and supporting interdisciplinary research. The awards and expenditures schedules in this report include sponsored programs at centers and institutes throughout the University but their activities are not specifically identified in this report. In some cases, direct funding to a center or institute is shown under the heading "Special Programs," but in many instances, awards and expenditures reported under the regular academic departments are also related to one or more of the University's centers or institutes.

6. Proposal and Award Data: These were derived from the Office of Sponsored Programs (OSP) database. Data related to the *Expenditures* schedules were provided by the Grant and Contract Accounting Office (GCA).






