Changing from ACPI-PC to Standard-PC (Windows XP)

1. Go to the Device manager (click the right mouse-button on "My Computer", choose properties, change to Hardware then to Device manager. Click on Computer). **Or:** Click "Start"->"Control Panel"->"System"->"Hardware"->"Device Manager"

2. Open the Computer properties and go to Drivers. Click on "Update Driver" and choose "Install from a list or specific location (Advanced)". Click on "Don't search. I will choose the driver to install" and choose the "Standard PC". Click next to proceed.
