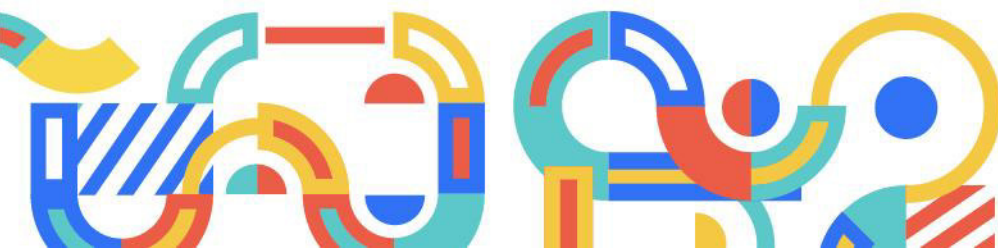
Athlete eligibility

The athletes must have signed and submitted the Athlete Eligibility Condition Form. All participating athletes must be at least 14 years old.

If the NOC that qualified at the Cali 2021 Junior Pan American Games does not participate in the Santiago 2023 Pan American Games, this place will be forfeited and cannot be transferred to another NOC or athlete.

Archers who earned places at the Junior Pan American Games may compete to earn team places for their countries in the other qualifiers, but not for an additional individual place for their countries.

The gold medal winners in the **compound** categories in Cali will participate in the individual competition in Santiago 2023. They can also join other archers from their countries to compete in the women's, men's and mixed team events.

The gold medal winners in the **recurve** categories in Cali will compete in Santiago under the following conditions:

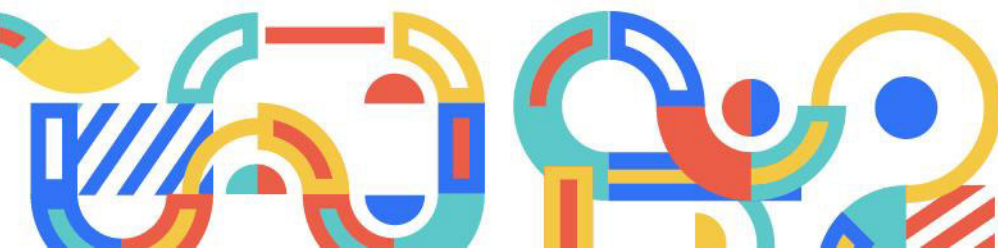
- If they represent countries that did not earn team places for Santiago 2023, they can participate in the individual competition, even if their inclusion leads the country to have two archers in the category in question. The elimination round would begin with a 1/32 match.
- If they represent countries that have qualified a full team in that category, they will start the qualifying round and may be chosen for the team rounds of their gender or mixed teams. They will be able to continue in the Individual Olympic Round only if their countries choose them as one of the three archers who will compete individually for medals or places for the Olympic Games. In this case, the individual round would start at the 1/16 stage since only 32 athletes would advance.

Qualification system

The present Qualification System has been designed to ensure 8 recurve teams and 5 compound teams of each gender, as well as the participation of individual archers from as many countries as possible. For this reason, a country can qualify either a 3-archers team or just one archer. As provided for the Olympic Games, a country cannot participate with two archers in one category for Santiago, except if one of the archers qualified at the Pan American Junior Games in Cali.

As there are countries (Colombia, Venezuela, Panama and Guyana) whose geographical location allows them to compete at the South American Games and the Central American and Caribbean Games, their National Federations must inform World Archery Americas by July 31, 2022, in which of these two Games they want to be considered for Pan American Games qualifying positions. This information must be provided in writing and must be accompanied by a letter of approval of their respective National Olympic Committee.

As Canada and the United States do not compete in any of the Regional Games, they will be the only countries eligible to earn spots in the North American Qualifier.



The participants by category in the Pan American Games will be:

- Recurve Women: 33 (8 teams + 8 individual archers from 8 different countries + the gold medal winner of the Cali 2021 Pan American Junior Games)
- Recurve Men: 33 (8 teams + 8 individual archers from 8 different countries + the gold medal winner of the Cali 2021 Pan American Junior Games)
- Recurve Mixed Teams: As many teams as countries that qualified at least one man and one woman.
- Compound Women: 16 (5 two-member teams + 5 individual archers from 5 different countries + the gold medal winner of the Pan American Junior Games).
- Compound Men: 16 (5 two-member teams + 5 individual archers from 5 different countries + the gold medal winner of the Pan American Junior Games).
- Compound Mixed Team: As many teams as countries that qualified at least one man and one woman.

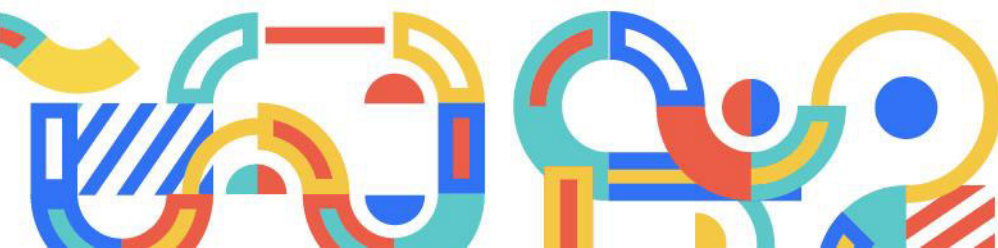
Places for Chile as host country:

- 3 for the men's recurve event
- 3 for the women's recurve event
- 1 for the men's compound event
- 1 for the women's compound event

Chile will be able to earn team quotas in the men's and women's compound team events only if the country is ranked among the top five finishers in the Pan American Championships.

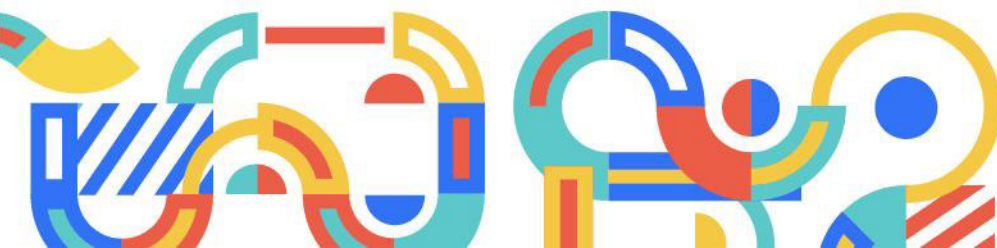

 - Recurve Men - 1 spot (individual gold medal winner)
 - Recurve Women - 1 spot (individual gold medal winner)
 - Compound Men – 1 spot (individual gold medal winner)
 - Compound Women - 1 spot (individual gold medal winner)

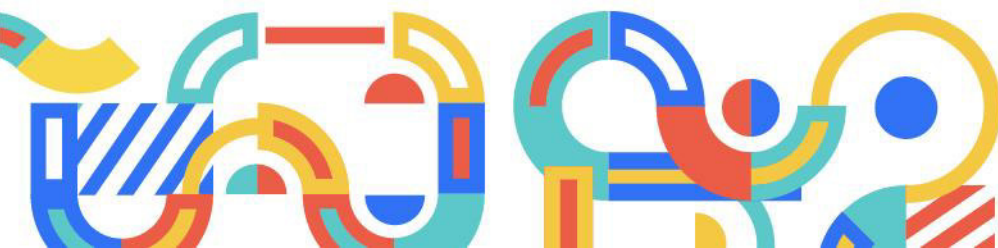
- **Pan American Championship, Santiago de Chile, November 21st – 27th, 2022**
 - Recurve Men: 18 spots
 - The top five teams of the team match play round (15). If Chile ranks in the top five, the sixth-ranked team will qualify.
 - The top three individual archers of a separate round in which the countries that won team spots will not be included. The country that qualified an archer in the South American Championships will not be included either.
 - If a country that won an individual spot at the South American Championships wins a team position in the Pan American Championships, the individual spot won in Asuncion will no longer be valid and will be reallocated in the individual round to qualify for the Pan American Games at the Pan American Championships. This means that 4 individual positions will be allocated.
 - Each country eligible to compete in the individual qualifier can enter up to three archers but can only earn one individual position.

 - Recurve Women: 18 spots
 - The top five teams in team match play round (15). If Chile ranks in the top five, the sixth-ranked team will qualify.
 - The top three individual archers of a separate round in which the countries that won team spots will not be included. The country that qualified an archer in the South American Championships will not be included either.
 - If the country that won the individual spot at the South American Championships wins a team position in the Pan American Championships, the individual spot won in Asuncion will no longer be valid and will be reallocated in the individual round to qualify for the Pan American Games at the Pan American Championships. This means that 4 individual positions will be allocated.
 - Each country eligible to compete in the individual qualifier can enter up to three archers but can only earn one individual position.

 - Compound Men: 11 spots
 - The top five two-member teams in match play round (10).
 - The top (1) individual archer in a separate round in which the countries that won team spots will not be included. The country that qualified an archer in the South American Championships will not be included either.



- If the country that won the individual spot at the South American Championships wins a team position at the Pan American Championships, the individual spot won in Asuncion will no longer be valid and will be reallocated in the individual round to qualify for the Games at the Pan American Championships. This means that 2 individual positions will be allocated.
 - Each country eligible to compete in the individual qualifier can enter up to three archers but can earn only one individual position.
 - Compound Women: 11 spots
 - The top five two-member teams in match play round (10).
 - The top (1) individual archer in a separate round in which the countries that won team spots will not be included. The country that qualified an archer in the South American Championships will not be included either.
 - If the country that won the individual spot at the South American Championships wins a team position at the Pan American Championships, the individual spot won in Asuncion will no longer be valid and will be reallocated in the individual round to qualify for the Games at the Pan American Championships. This means that 2 individual positions will be allocated.
 - Each country eligible to compete in the individual qualifier can enter up to three archers but can earn only one individual position.
- **North American Qualifier** – During the 2022 Pan American Championship
 - Recurve men (1 spot)
 - To the highest ranked individual archer of this geographical region from a country that did not earn a team or individual position for the Pan American Games in the Pan American Championships.
 - To qualify for North America, the archer must be ranked in the top 8 positions in the special individual qualifier for the Pan American Games at the Pan American Championships.
 - If the North American countries earn the possible spots in the team round or in the special individual qualifier round of this event, the North American spot will be allocated at the last qualifier of 2023 and will be made available to all countries of the continent.
 - Recurve women (1 spot)
 - To the highest ranked individual archer of this geographical region from a country that did not earn a team or individual position for the Games at the Pan American Championships.
 - To qualify for North America, the archer must be ranked in the top 8 positions in the special individual qualifier for the Pan American Games at the Pan American Championships.



- If the North American countries earn the possible spots in the team round or in the special individual qualifier round of this event, the North American spot will be allocated at the last qualifier of 2023 and will be made available to all countries of the continent.

As the North American region's number of countries is smaller compared to the number of South American and Central American and Caribbean countries, no separate positions will be allocated to North America for the men's and women's compound events.

- **Central American and Caribbean Games, El Salvador, June 23rd – July 8th, 2023**

- Recurve Men (1 spot)

- To the highest ranked individual archer from a country that did not earn a spot at the 2022 Pan American Championships. The archer must be ranked among the top 8 positions of the Individual Olympic Round at the Central American & Caribbean Games to be eligible for this spot.

- Recurve Women (1 spot)

- To the highest ranked individual archer from a country that did not win a spot at the 2022 Pan American Championships. The archer must be ranked among the top 8 positions of the Individual Olympic Round at the Central American & Caribbean Games to be eligible for this spot.

- Compound Men (1 spot)

- To the highest ranked individual archer from a country that did not earn a spot at the 2022 Pan American Championships. The archer must be ranked among the top 8 positions of the Individual Olympic Round at the Central American & Caribbean Games to be eligible for this spot.

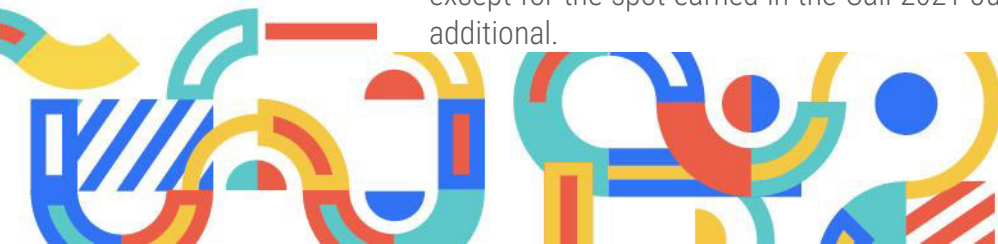
- Compound women (1 spot)

- To the highest ranked individual archer from a country that did not earn a spot at the 2022 Pan American Championships. The archer must be ranked among the top 8 positions of the Individual Olympic Round at the Central American & Caribbean Games to be eligible for this spot.

- **The last qualifier**

- Recurve men (8 spots)

- 6 spots for the top two teams in a match play round involving only the countries that did not earn team spots at the Pan American Championships.
- 2 individual spots for the top ranked archers in a special match play round involving up to three archers from the countries that did not earn a team or individual spot at the previous qualifiers. The number of individual spots to be allocated can be increased to 4 if the countries that earned team spots in the last qualifier had already won individual positions in previous qualifiers. No country can earn more than one individual position for any category including the results of all qualifiers, except for the spot earned in the Cali 2021 Junior Pan American Games, which is additional.



Recurve women (8 spots)

- 6 spots for the top two teams in a match play round involving only the countries that did not earn team spots at the Pan American Championships.
 - 2 individual spots for the top ranked archers in a special match play round involving up to three archers from the countries that did not earn a team or individual spot at the previous qualifiers. The number of individual spots to be allocated can be increased to 4 if the countries that earned team spots in the last qualifier had already won individual positions in previous qualifiers. No country can earn more than one individual position for any category including the results of all qualifiers, except for the spot earned in the Cali 2021 Junior Pan American Games, which is additional.
- Compound Men (1 spot)
 - To the top ranked archer in a special match round involving up to three archers from countries that have not earned a spot in any of the previous qualifiers.
 - Compound women (1 spot)
 - To the top ranked archer in a special match round involving up to three archers from countries that have not earned a spot in any of the previous qualifiers.

Confirmation of quota places

WA will confirm to Panam Sports and to the NOCs the places they have qualified by July 10th, 2023.

The NOCs will confirm to Panam Sports and to WA the places they will use by July 14th, 2023.

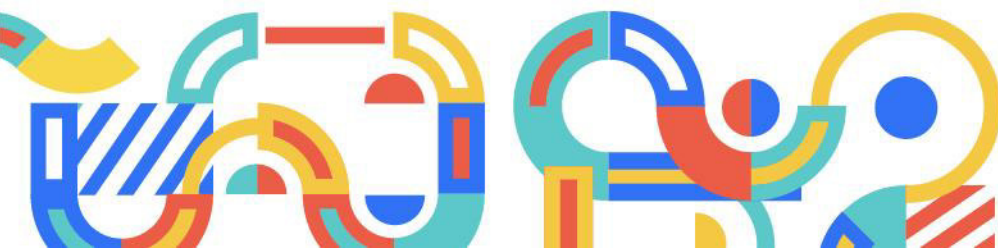
Reallocation of unused quota places

If necessary, WA will reallocate unused quota places to the next NOC whose athletes have been ranked on an alternate list after the second qualifying tournament. This process must be finalized by July 17th, 2023.

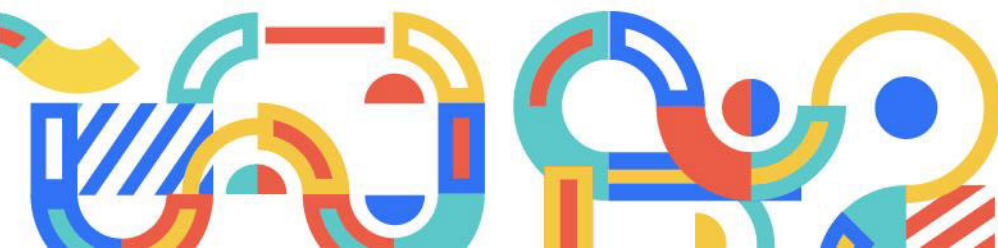
The NOCs that receive reallocated quotas must confirm their participation no later than on July 19th, 2023.

Qualification for the Paris 2024 Olympic Games

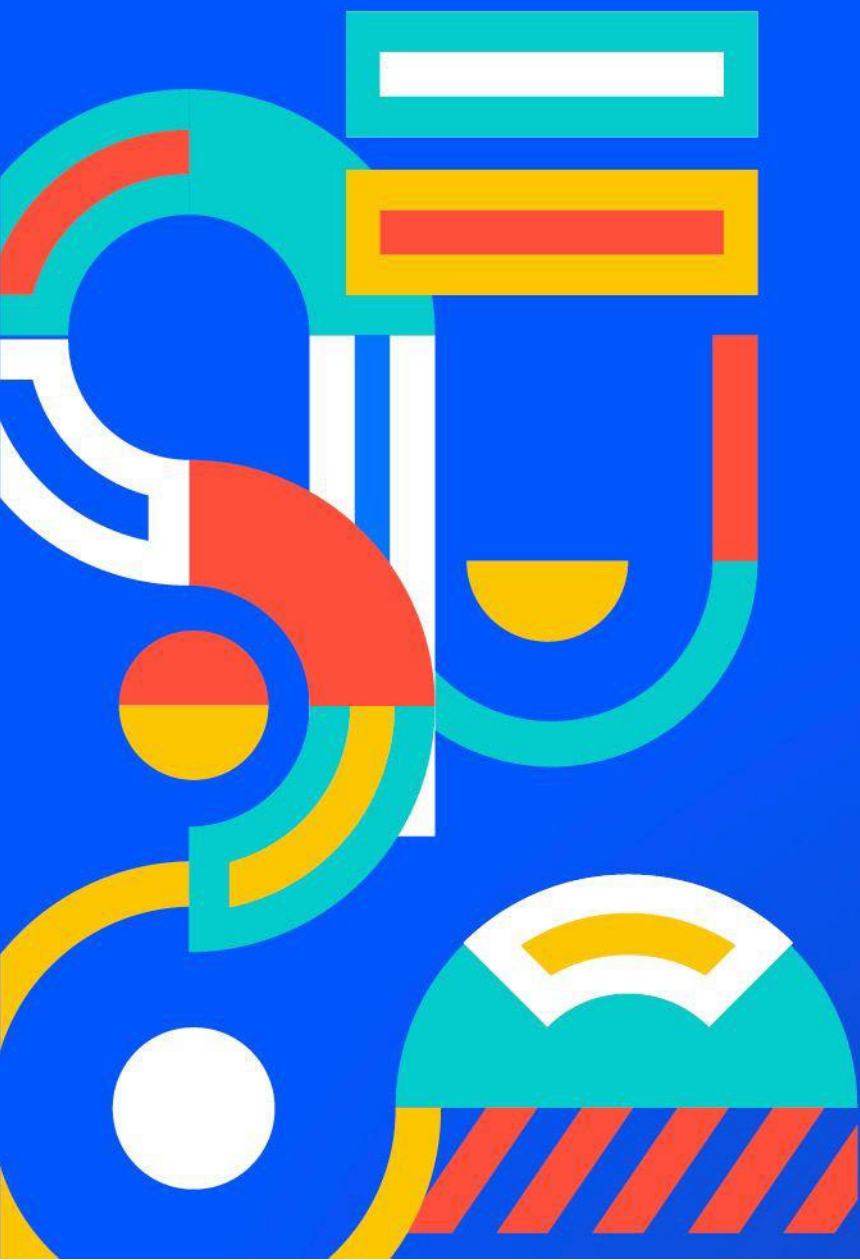

Athletes must have signed and submitted the athlete eligibility conditions form. Athletes must be at least 15 years old by January 1st, 2023.

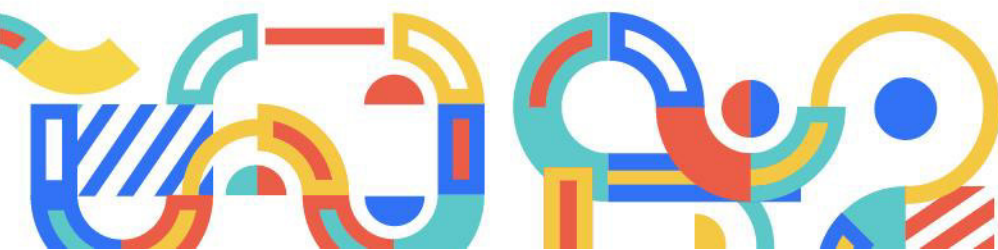
Only NOCs recognized by the Pan American Sports Organization (Panam Sports) and whose National Federation is a member of the International Bowling Federation (IBF) and American Zone – Pan American Bowling Confederation (Panam Bowling) may enter competitors in the Santiago 2023 Pan American Games.

The athletes who qualified at the Cali 2021 Junior Pan American Games will only be able to compete in the individual events of the Santiago 2023 Pan American Games.



If the athletes who qualified at the Cali 2021 Junior Pan American Games do not participate in the Santiago 2023 Pan American Games, said place will be forfeited and cannot be transferred to another NOC or athlete.

Qualified athletes at the Cali 2021 Junior Pan American Games will not be able to obtain another slot for their NOC; however, another athlete may compete for another slot through the Santiago 2023 qualification system within the maximum quota per NOC.

Qualification system

Each PBC member country must choose two competitions in which they will take part to qualify. ONLY those two competitions will be considered for qualification.

12 countries will be competing in said Games with 2 athletes per gender and per qualified country for a total of 24 athletes in doubles per gender. These same athletes will compete in the individual event, in which the medalists of the individual event of the Cali 2021 Junior Pan American Games will receive a quota, for a total of 25 athletes per gender in the individual event.

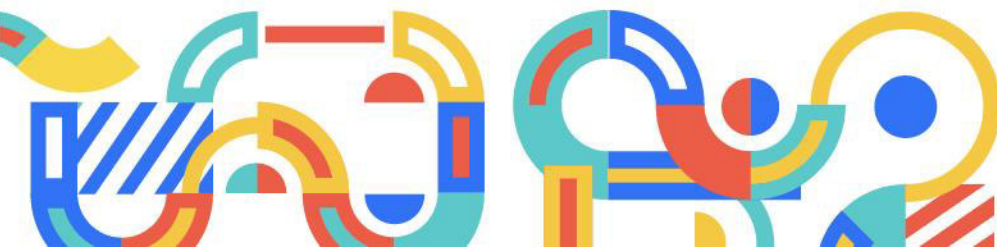
In view of the fact that Canada and the USA do not participate in the Central American and Caribbean Games (CAC) and the South American Games (ODESUR), official competitions of the Olympic cycle, they will only have the opportunity to qualify in the Panam Bowling official competitions. Thus, we will limit all countries to just 2 competitions in which they may seek qualification in order to be fair and give equal opportunities to every country.

Based on this information, all countries **MUST INFORM BEFORE JULY 1st, 2022, WHICH 2 COMPETITIONS THEY WILL CHOOSE TO SEEK QUALIFICATION.**



Any discrepancy or dispute about the process that we may have will be solved by the Executive Board and will be informed on due time.

Panam Bowling will confirm to Panam Sports and to the NOCs the places they have qualified by July 11th, 2023.

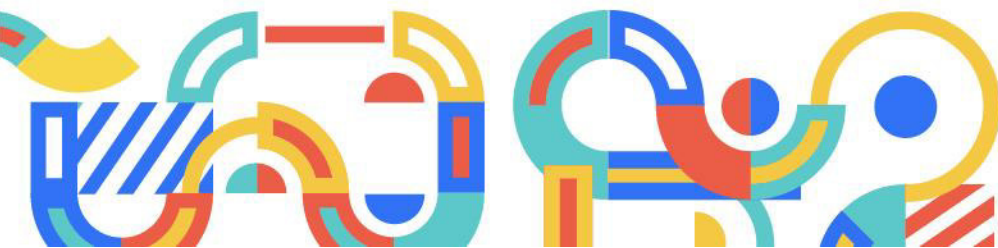
The NOCs will confirm to Panam Sports and to Panam Bowling the places they will use by July 14th, 2023.

Reallocation of unused quota places

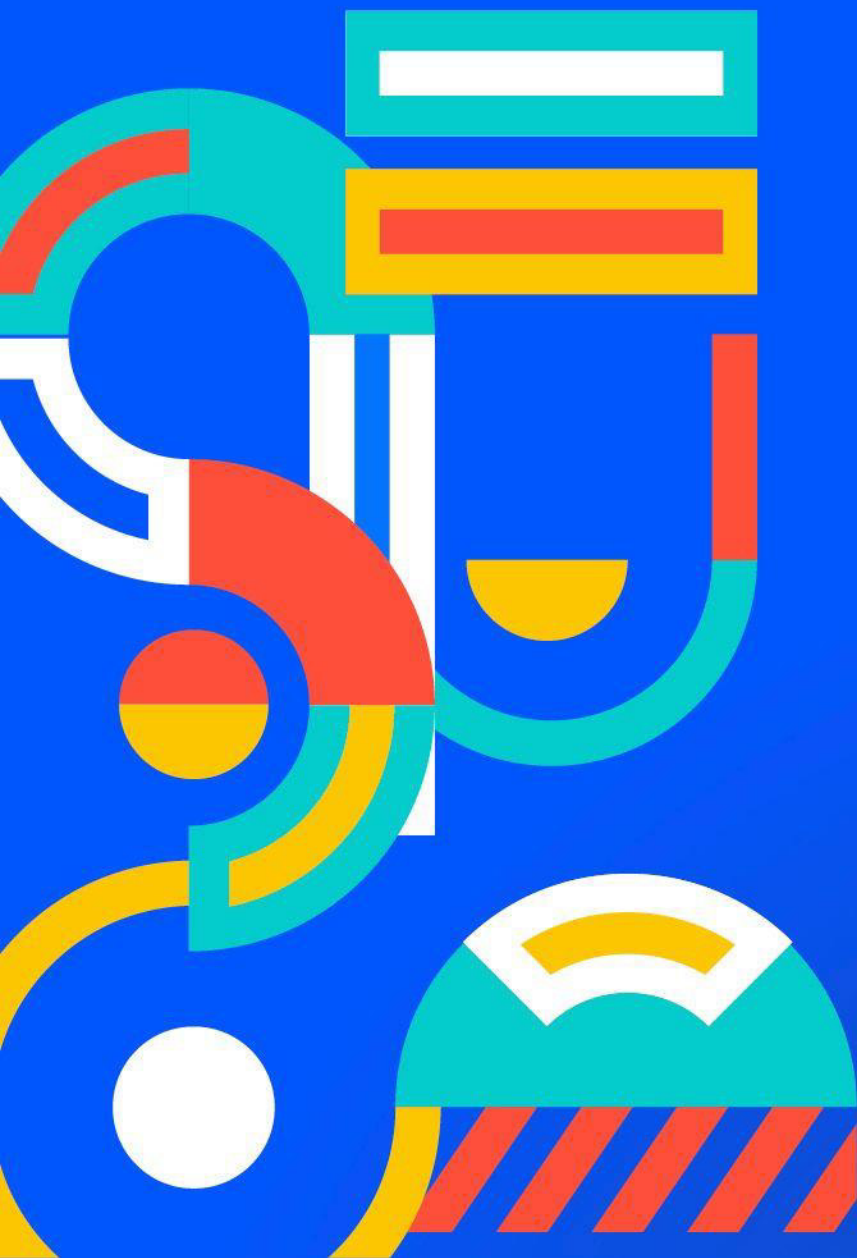
If necessary, Panam Bowling will reallocate unused quota places to the next best ranked NOC that has not qualified yet. This process will finalize by July 15th, 2023.

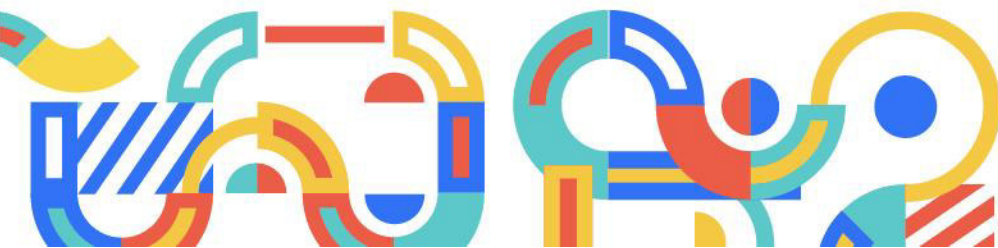

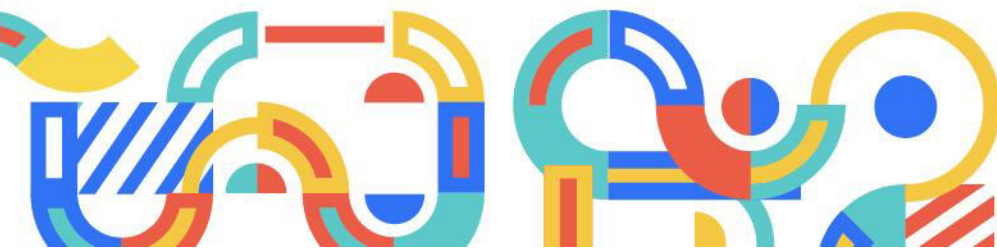

Qualification Rules

1. The NOCs that finish in places 1 to 6 in the Kayak final event and in places 1 to 7 in the Canoe final event of the Olympic program events of the Qualification Regatta, will qualify for the 2023 Pan American Games.
2. An athlete can only qualify one boat for his/her NOC.
3. In Kayak, boats and athletes' quotas will be allocated first to K4, then to K2 and then to K1.
4. If an athlete is member of a boat that qualifies for K4 and competes as well in K2 and/or K1 in the Qualification Regatta, the K2 and/or K1 results will not be considered for the purpose of the allocation of quotas to boats and athletes.



5. If an athlete is member of a boat that qualifies for K2 and competes as well in K1 in the Qualification Regatta, this K1 result will not be considered for the purpose of allocation of quotas to boats and athletes.
6. In Canoe, athlete quotas will be assigned first to C2 and then to C1.
7. If an athlete is member of a boat that qualifies in C2 and competes as well in C1 in the Qualification Regatta, this C1 result will not be considered for the purpose of allocation of quotas to boats and athletes.

Qualification Consequences

1. In an NOC qualifies in MK4 500m, this NOC must compete in MK1 1,000m and MK2 500m.
2. If an NOC qualifies in WK4 500m, this NOC must compete in WK1 500m and WK2 500m.
3. If an NOC qualifies in MC2 500m, this NOCS must compete in MC1 1,000m.
4. If an NOC qualifies in WC2 500m, this NOC must compete in WC1 200m.

If an NOC has more qualified athletes than the maximum quota allowed in Men's Kayak or Women's Kayak, the excess quota of athletes will be allocated to the next highest ranked eligible boat in the K1 Olympic event in the Qualification Regatta.

Host country representation (Chile)

If the host NOC (Chile) does not qualify in the K1 or C1 events in both genders, it will be allocated a quota in said event. If this happens, the number of K1 or C1 qualified athletes in that category in the Qualification Regatta will be reduced by one.

Confirmation of quota places

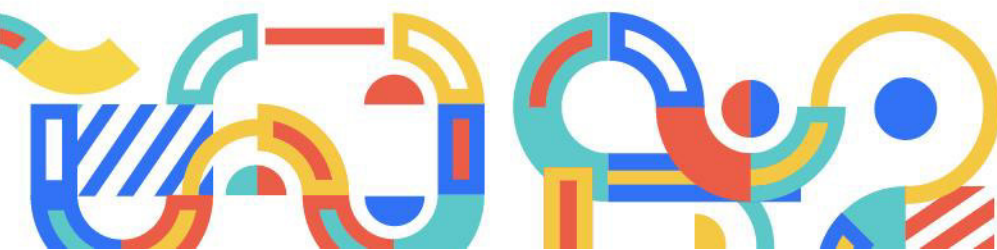
COPAC will confirm to Panam Sports and to the NOCs the places that each NOC has qualified no later than August 29th, 2022.

NOCs will confirm to Panam Sports and COPAC the places they will use no later than September 2nd, 2022.

Reallocation of unused quota places

If an NOC does not accept all its quotas or does not use all its quotas to complete its entries by number for the 2023 Pan American Games, the reallocation of these quotas will be done at the discretion of the COPAC President on the recommendation of the COPAC Canoe Sprint Committee.

There will be no reallocation of quotas between categories. The reassignment will be made according to the following guidelines:

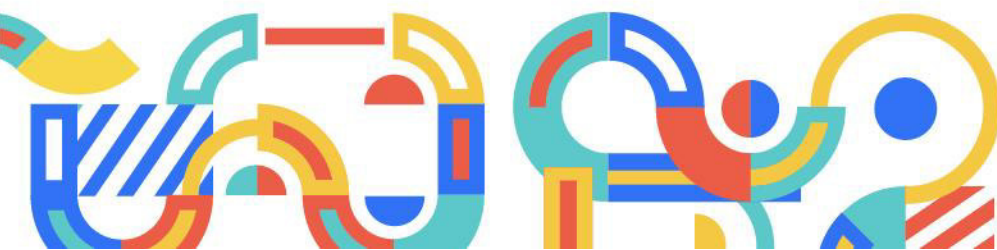


1. If an NOC returns one quota in a category, said quota must be reallocated to the next highest ranked NOC that has not yet qualified in that category in the individual Olympic event of the Qualification Regatta;
2. If an NOC returns two quotas in a category, the quotas must be reallocated to the next highest ranked NOC that has not yet qualified in that category in the Olympic doubles event of the Qualification Regatta;
3. If an NOC returns three quotas in a category, the quotas must be reallocated to the next highest ranked NOC that has not yet qualified in that category in the individual Olympic event of the Qualification Regatta, and to the next highest ranked NOC that has not yet qualified for the doubles event of said category in the Qualification Regatta;
4. If an NOC returns four quotas in a Kayak category, the quotas must be reallocated to the next highest ranked NOC that has not yet qualified in that category for the K4 Olympic event of the Qualification Regatta.

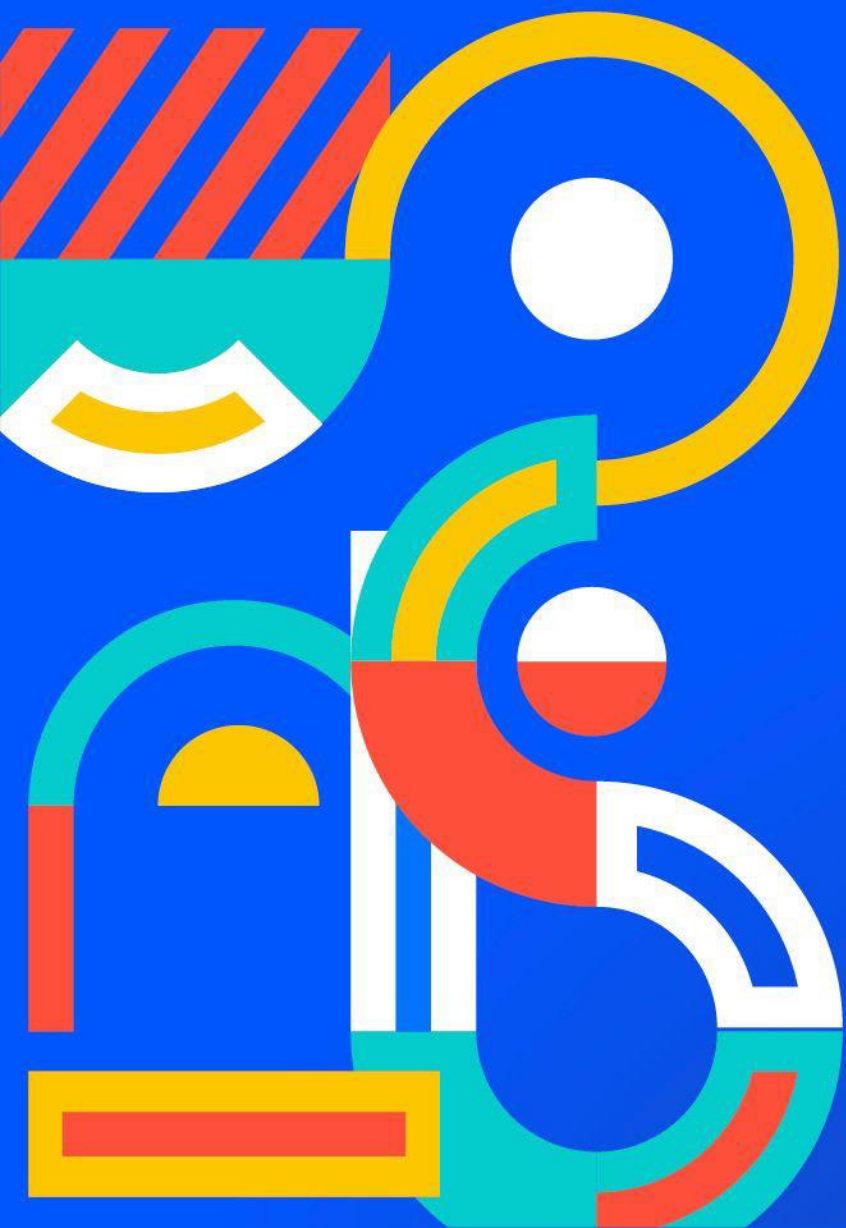
This process should be completed before September 16th, 2022.

An athlete may qualify their NOC for the Santiago 2023 Pan American Games only when eligible to represent that NOC under World Sailing Olympic Qualifying Eligibility rules and Panam Sports regulations. Nationality rules apply to all members of the crew.



An athlete qualified by name in an event (see Cali 2021 quotas section) is not eligible to qualify their NOC for a country place in that event or any other, but a different athlete from the same NOC may do so.

Equipment Class Rules requiring competitors to be members of Equipment Class Associations shall apply.

An athlete who has qualified himself / herself or their NOC in an event may not thereafter qualify another NOC in that event or any other, irrespective of any change in their nationality as defined by Panam Sports, or their ability to claim multiple citizenship.

Qualification system

The host country will automatically qualify one boat place in each of the 13 Pan American sailing events.

The highest placed not yet qualified NOCs in each of the relevant events at designated Qualifying Regattas will qualify one boat place per event according to the quotas presented in the table in Section of Maximum Quota Per Event.

For purposes of NOC qualification in men's and women's events, men and women shall be ranked separately in regattas where men and women race together.

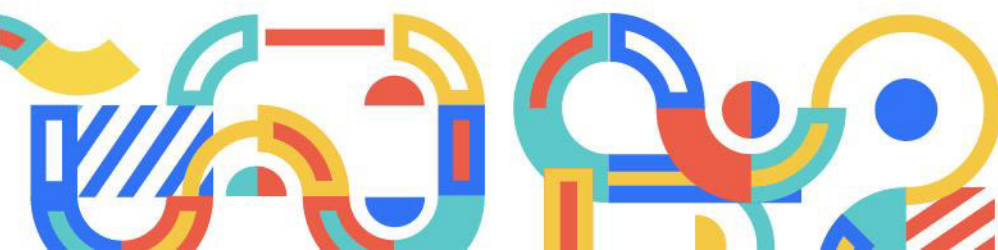
An athlete who has qualified their NOC in any event may not thereafter qualify the NOC in another event.

Competitors intending to qualify a NOC in a SANTIAGO 2023 event designated as MIXED in the Section of Maximum Quota Per Event will be required to compete as MIXED in the Qualifying Regatta. The NOR for the Qualifying Regatta shall include an article confirming this requirement.

Class Rules requiring competitors to be members of Class Associations shall apply.

Athletes from a minimum of three countries must compete in the relevant event at a Qualifying Regatta for it to be considered valid.

If a designated Qualifying Regatta is cancelled or fails to meet the requirement for a valid series, the places will be divided among valid regattas for the relevant event(s) in a proportion determined by the Qualification Committee. The Qualification Committee will attempt to maintain continental balance with respect to location in the selection of alternate Qualifying Regattas.



The Notice of Race of a Qualifying Regatta shall be reviewed and approved by Panam Sailing at least four (4) months before the event.

The Notice of Race of a Qualifying Regatta shall specify that:

- a) For purposes of country qualification for the 2023 Pan American Games, the Qualifying System and Regatta Schedule, Sailing - 2023 Pan American Games, Santiago, Chile (Qualifying System), shall apply. See <http://panamsailing.org>
- b) All events designated as qualifiers for the Pan American Games shall conform with the formats specified for those events in the Section of Maximum Quota Per Event of the Qualifying System.
- c) Competitors intending to qualify a country in a SANTIAGO 2023 event designated as MIXED in the Section of Maximum Quota Per Event will be required to compete as MIXED in the Qualifying Regatta. In the Lightning Equipment Class this means 1 Man and 2 Women.
- d) A competitor may qualify a country for the 2023 Pan American Games only when eligible to represent that country under IOC and Panam Sports and World Sailing rules and shall provide their valid World Sailing ID number to the organizer.
- e) Class Rules requiring competitors to be members of the relevant Class Associations shall apply.

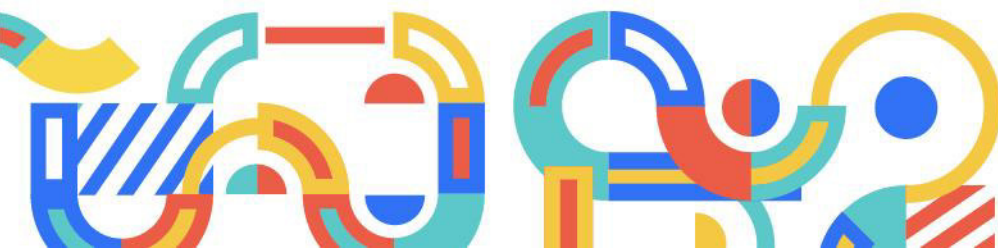
The Principal Race Officer (PRO) for a Qualifying Regatta shall be certified as a World Sailing International Race Officer (IRO). Requests for replacement of the International Race Officer with a nationally certified Race Officer must be submitted for approval by Panam Sailing at least 30 days prior to the start of the regatta.

The International Measurer who serves as the Equipment Inspector Chief shall chair the Technical Committee for a qualifying Regatta and shall be certified as a World Sailing International Measurer (IM). Requests for replacement of the International Measurer with a nationally certified Measurer must be submitted for approval by Panam Sailing at least 30 days prior to the start of the regatta.

The Protest Committee for a Qualifying Regatta shall be constituted as an International Jury in accordance with Appendix N of the 2021-2024 Racing Rules of Sailing. The Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions shall specify that the right of appeal is denied, as per RRS 70.5.

The Qualifying Regattas for each event of the 2023 Pan American Games and the number of boat places allocated to each regatta are listed in this document.

Qualifying Regattas shall not be held before April 1, 2022. All Qualifying Regattas shall be completed no later than July 8th, 2023.

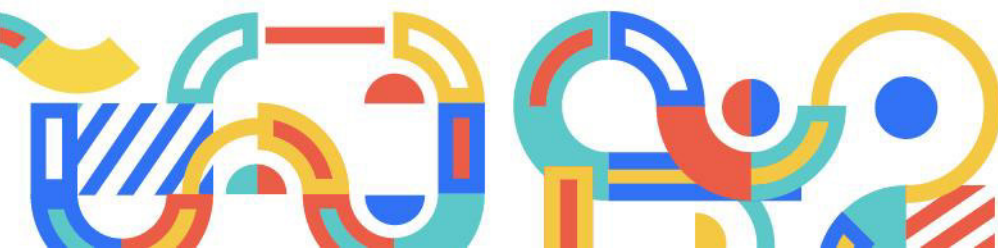

NOCs shall confirm to Panam Sports and Panam Sailing the places they will use no later than July 14th, 2023.

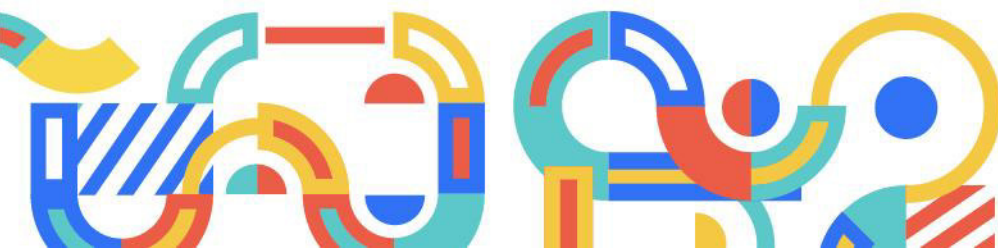
Allocation of universality quota places

- NOCs/MNAs shall submit applications for universality quota place(s) no later than July 11th, 2023.
- Panam Sailing shall confirm the allocation of universality quota places to the NOCs and Panam Sports no later than July 13th, 2023.
- NOCs shall confirm their intention to use allocated universality quota places to Panam Sports and Panam Sailing no later than July 14th, 2023.
- Universality places will be allocated by the Qualification Committee according to the following criteria:
 - Results of the designated athlete in the Qualification Regattas, in World, Continental and Regional Championships and in Equipment Class Championships.
 - The WS World Rankings (if applicable).
 - Continental balance with respect to NOC representation in the specified event and in the sailing competition overall at the 2023 Pan American Games.

Reallocation of unused quota places

If necessary, Panam Sailing will reallocate unused quota places no later than July 15th, 2023, according to the process outlined below.

NOCs that received reallocated quotas shall confirm their intention to use the places to Panam Sports and Panam Sailing no later than July 17th, 2023.

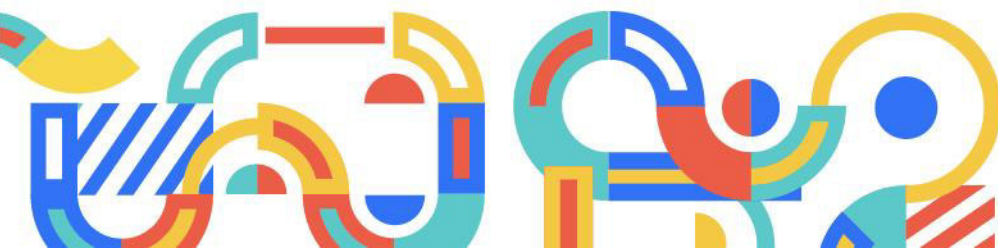

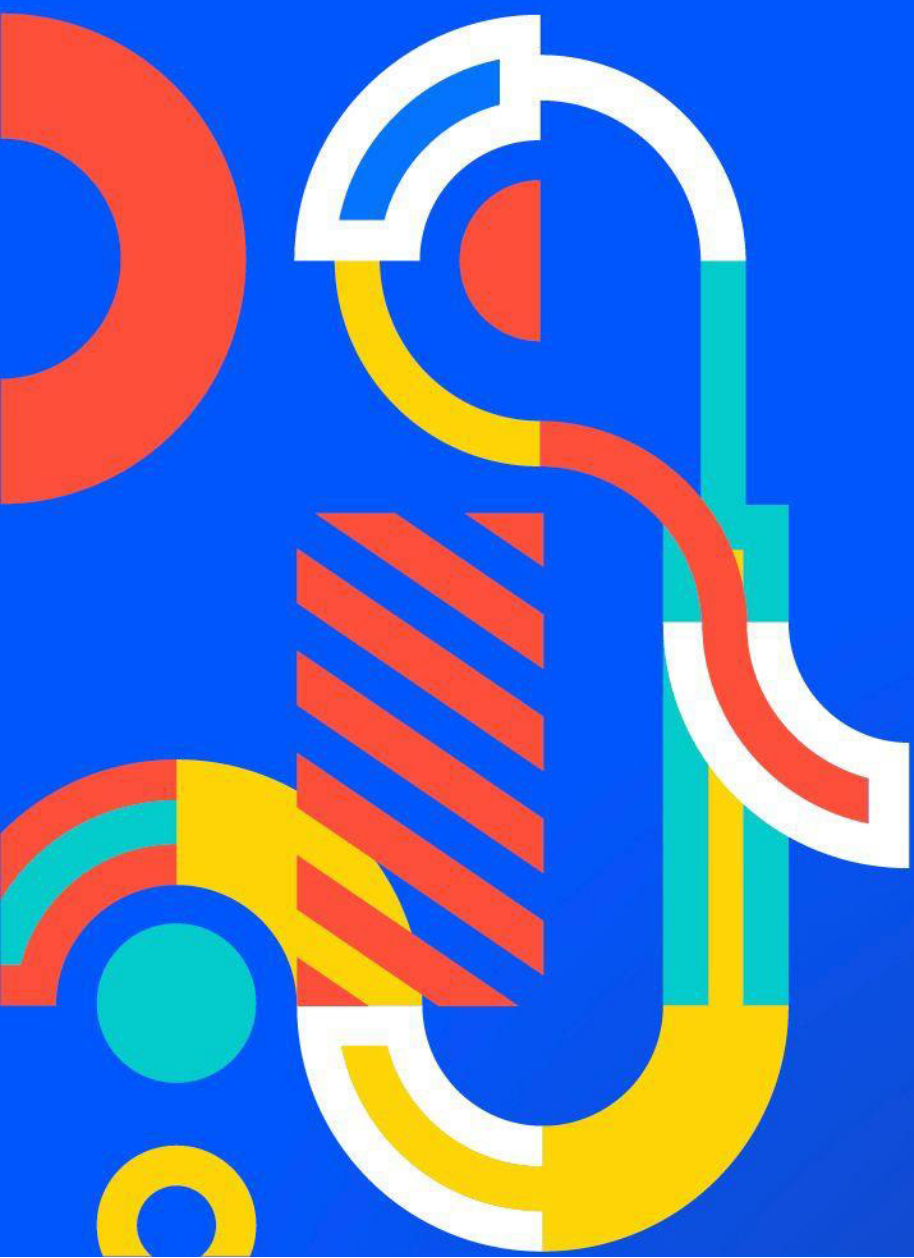

The Qualification Committee may reallocate places from one event to another.

All the NOCs that earned quotas at the Cali 2021 Junior Pan American Games must participate (with the same athlete or with another athlete of the same weight category) in the 2022 and 2023 qualification events. The NOCs that have qualified athletes at Cali 2021 and the 2022 Pan American Senior Championship in Acapulco must participate in the 2023 Pan American Senior Championship in Buenos Aires. Otherwise, the NOC that does not participate with an athlete WILL LOSE THE QUOTA and said quota will be allocated in the corresponding championship to the next highest-ranked NOC that has not qualified yet.

If an NOC that qualified at the Cali 2021 Junior Pan American Games does not want to participate in the Santiago 2023 Pan American Games in the category it qualified for, said quota will be lost and cannot be transferred to another NOC or athlete.

The NOCs that qualified at the Cali 2021 Junior Pan American Games must confirm their participation by April 30, 2022.

According to the regulations of Panam Sports, the host country (Chile) is automatically qualified for all categories included in the Santiago 2023 Pan American Games.

However, Chile must participate (in both Pan American Senior Championships) with a representative in a weight division if it wants to have a quota for said category. For example, if Chile wants to qualify for FS 57 kg, an athlete from Chile must participate in both Pan American Championships (Acapulco, Mexico 2022 and Buenos Aires, Argentina 2023) to confirm the quota for the Santiago 2023 Pan American Games. It should be noted that the participating athlete may be different in both championships.

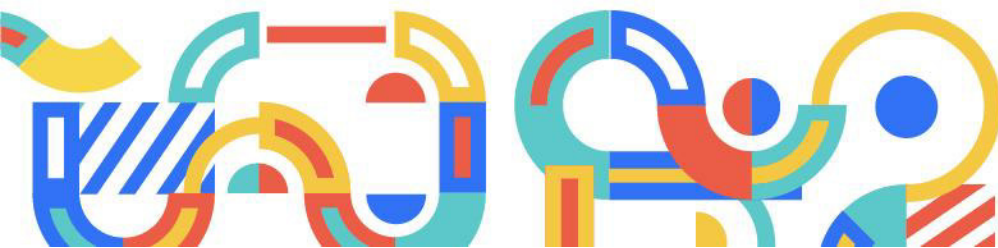
If at the end of the three qualifying events Chile does not qualify any athlete for a weight category, only the 3 top athletes of the 2023 Pan American Senior Championship will qualify. This means that the 4th place will be awarded to the host country.

Any athlete who has qualified for a style or weight division cannot qualify for another style or weight division.

As of the second qualifying event, quotas will be granted in an ascending order to the countries that have not qualified yet. If necessary, an extra combat will be held to determine the final qualification spot.

The quota is for the country, not for the athlete.

To qualify for the 2023 Pan American Championship in Buenos Aires it is mandatory for any NOC to have been represented by an athlete in the same category (style and weight) than in the Acapulco 2022 Pan American Championship. The athlete may or may not be the same in each championship.



Wild Cards

United World Wrestling (UWW) and United World Wrestling Americas (UWWA) will award six wild cards to the NOCs based on the IOC universality principle, considering the following criteria:

- NOCs that participate in qualification events but have not qualified an athlete.
- Among these NOCs, the athletes with the best results at qualification events.

Confirmation of quotas

The NOCs that have qualified at the I Junior Pan American Games Cali 2021 must confirm their participation to Panam Sports and the UWWA by April 30, 2022.

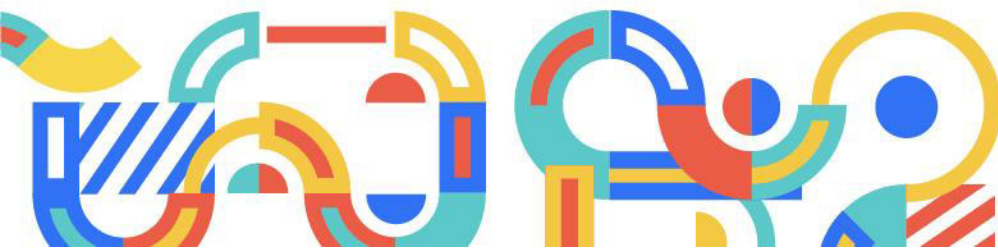
The UWWA will confirm to Panam Sports and to the NOCs the places they have qualified no later than May 15, 2023.

The NOCs must confirm the places they will use to Panam Sports and the UWWA no later than May 22, 2023.

Reallocation of unused quota places

If necessary, the UWWA will reallocate unused quotas in the corresponding style/weight division to the next highest-ranked NOC at the qualification event in which the NOC that rejected the quota earned it. This process must be completed by May 24, 2023.

The NOCs that are allocated unused quotas must confirm their participation no later than May 26, 2023.
