Call for application

Stephen W. Kuffler Research Scholarship

The *Stephen W. Kuffler Research Foundation* (www.kuffler.org) welcomes applications for the Stephen W. Kuffler Awards supporting original research by undergraduate and medical students.

The application is open for bachelor, master and medical students who carried out original research in Central and Eastern Europe in the academic year 2017/18 and will continue it in the year 2018/19 in the fields of life or medical sciences. **In the academic year of 2018/19, the applicants should be still bachelor, master or medical students.**

A personal stipend is 500 000 HUF per annum and the duration of the Fellowship is one year.

The application form is available online at www.kuffler.org. Applications should be sent as one pdf file to kuffler@koki.mta.hu before **30th April 2018**.

Two reference letters (pdf files), one from a scientific advisor and one from another faculty member or colleague, **should be sent by the sponsors directly to kuffler@koki.mta.hu before 30th April 2018.**

The application will be judged and ranked by the Trustees of the Foundation based on the scientific excellence and future potential of the applicants. The winners will be announced and their names will be displayed on the web site of the *Foundation* (www.kuffler.org) on 1st July 2018. The *Foundation* will follow the developments of the Awardees and will request a short summary of the performed research after the completion of the Fellowship. The *Foundation* also aims to follow and support the scientific career of the Scholars after the end of the support period.
