Subject: Florida Statewide survey conducted for FloridaPolitics.com

Date: November 19, 2021

Executive Summary:

This poll of 2,896 registered Florida voters was conducted from November 18th to November 19th, 2021. This poll used the registered voter lists supplied by the state of Florida as of June 15th 2021. The sample of voters that were contacted included random samples of registered voters within the boundaries of the state of Florida.

The issues surveyed included questions related to the 2022 general election in Florida.

Methodology:

The poll was conducted through an automated phone call polling system. The results were then weighted to account for proportional differences between the respondents' demographics and the demographics of the active voter population for the state of Florida.

The scientific results shown for the questions below have a sample size of 2,896 and a 1.8% Margin of Error at a 95% confidence level.
