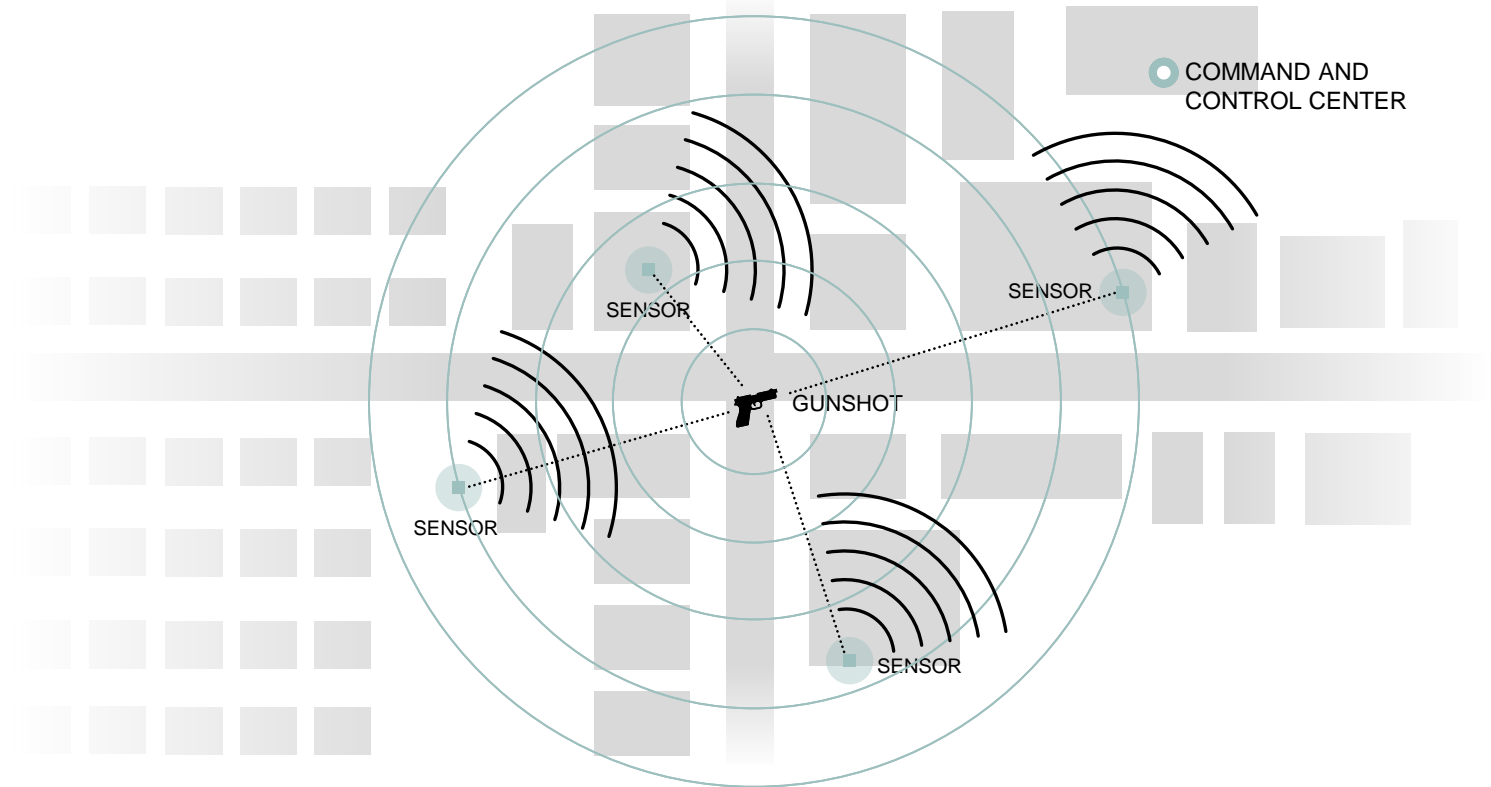


People call police LESS THAN 20% OF THE TIME

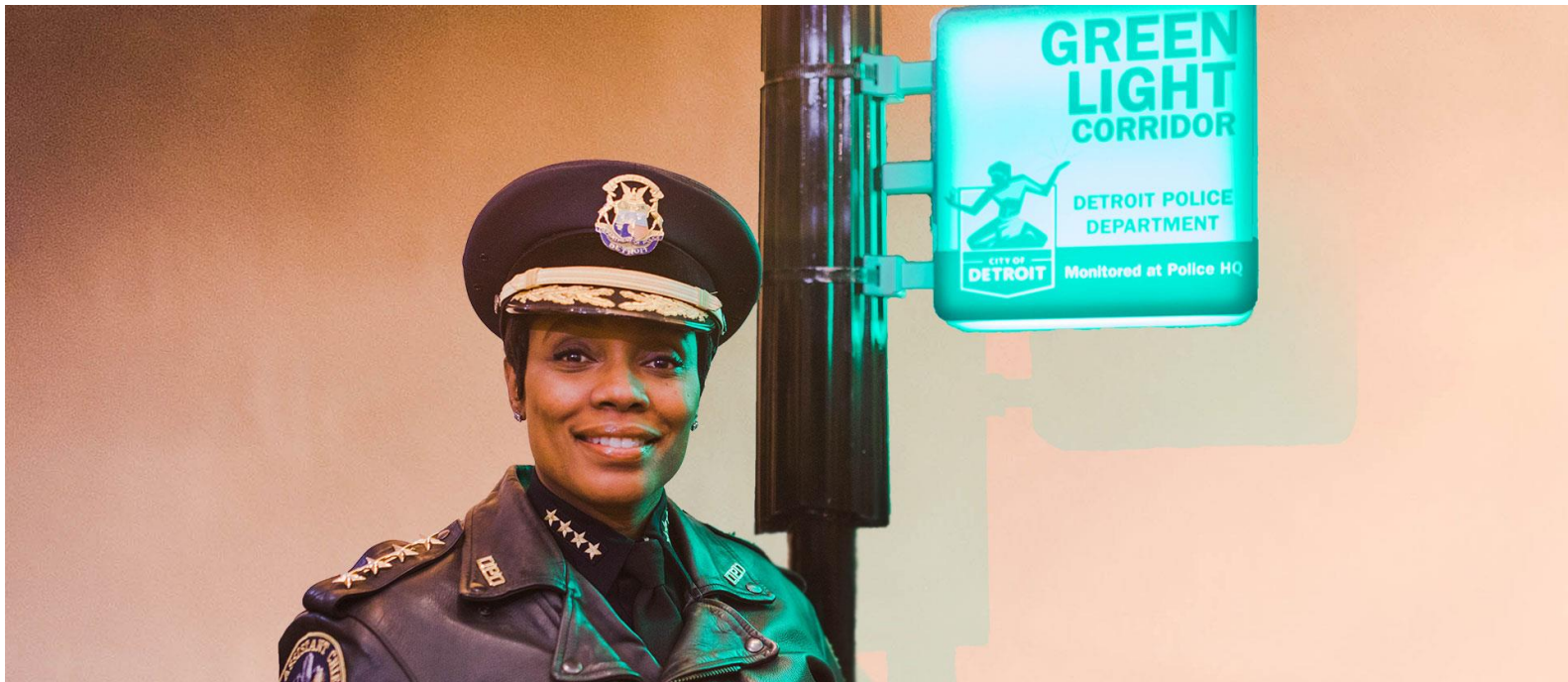

2014 City/County Task Force Presentation

- *Real Time Crime Center-* Staffed with non-sworn employees monitoring the video systems throughout the city- downtown, traffic, and private enterprises willing to provide access- and providing “as it occurs” crime information and analysis.
 - **\$3,837,131**
 - **\$3,000.000*** for facility and equipment
 - **\$837,131** -15 non-sworn staff (6-PSR, 6 -Crime Analysts, 3 -Supervisors salary and benefits)

**Amount provided by Memphis PD as the cost of their RTCC. This could be reduced considerably if a joint City-County RTCC was created, and an existing facility was utilized.*
