Teams that have already confirmed a quota place for their NOC to the Olympic Games Paris 2024 as a Host Country or through 2022/23 World Rugby HSBC Sevens World Series for Men or Women are not eligible to participate in the respective event in the 2023 European Games.





Only World Rugby and Rugby Europe full members can take part in the Qualification.

The NOCs participating in the 2023 European Games must confirm their participation to the Olympic Games to World Rugby in case they obtain a quota place at the same time as registering their team(s) for the 2023 European Games.

C. ATHLETE ELIGIBILITY

C.1. Compliance with the Olympic Charter and other relevant rules

All athletes must respect and comply with the provisions of the Olympic Charter currently in force, including but not limited to Rule 41 (Nationality of Competitors) and Rule 43 (World Anti-Doping Code and the Olympic Movement Code on the Prevention of Manipulation of Competitions).

Only those athletes who respect and comply with the Olympic Charter, the World Anti-Doping Code and the Olympic Movement Code on the Prevention of Manipulation of Competitions, including the conditions of participation established by the EOC and the rules of Rugby Europe and World Rugby, may participate in the 2023 European Games.

C.2. Age requirements

All athletes participating in Rugby events in the 2023 European Games must comply with the provisions of the World Rugby Elite Rugby Age Guidelines http://playerwelfare.worldrugby.org/?documentid=115

C.3. Additional Rugby Europe criteria

All athletes must comply with World Rugby Rule 8 on Eligibility: https://www.world.rugby/organisation/governance/regulations/reg-8

D. QUALIFICATION PATHWAY

The qualification system allows for the participation of the best athletes through a fair and transparent process within the framework of the Olympic Charter.

E. CONFIRMATION PROCESS FOR QUOTA PLACES

The EOC will inform by email the respective NOCs of their allocated quota places by July 31st 2022

By September 15th,2022, eligible NOCs must inform, by email, the EOC whether or not they intend to use the allocated quota places and participate at the 2023 European Games.

By the end of the HSBC World Series 2022-2023 in May 2023, and no later than 48 hours before the conclusion of the tournament and the official release of the ranking, the EOC, in agreement with the Rugby Europe and World Rugby, will reallocate all unused quota places.

F. REALLOCATION OF UNUSED QUOTA PLACES

Any unused quota place (including qualification places and host NOC places) will be allocated to the next best ranked NOC in qualification tournament in the respective event. This process will be repeated until all places are allocated.

H. SEEDING FOR THE EUROPEAN GAMES 2023

Rugby Europe will organize one leg of the RE championship Series 2023 and one leg of the RE Trophy Series 2023 before the European Games 2023. The ranking of both events will define the seeding for the European Games.

I. OLYMPIC GAMES PARIS 2024 QUALIFICATION

The winners of both men's and women's events will qualify a quota place for their NOC to the Olympic Games Paris 2024. Teams placed 2nd and 3rd in both men's and women's events will qualify to the Final Olympic Repechage Tournament.
