BASIC HISTORY

COMMAND ORGANIZATION

1. Commanding Officers.
 - a. 1 January - 17 July - Captain Thomas W. Mc NAMARA, USN
17 July - 31 December - Captain John A. BUCK, USN 1973
2. No mission or function changes occurred during the year.
3. Due to the reorganization of Cruiser-Destroyer Force, Pacific Fleet, CHICAGO came under administrative control of Commander Cruiser-Destroyer Group FIVE.
4. Effective 30 June 1973 CHICAGO changed homeports from Long Beach, California to San Diego, California.

SUMMARY OF OPERATIONS

On 25 August 1972 CHICAGO commenced a Complex Overhaul at Long Beach Naval Shipyard which was completed 1 September 1973. Commencing 15 May 1973 CHICAGO carried out a series of sea trials, tests and training evolutions to prove accomplished overhaul and alternation work and train the crew in the use of their new equipments. CHICAGO was certified operationally ready at the completion of Ship Qualification Trials (SQT) on 14 December. On 1 June CHICAGO, as a pilot ship, implemented the Combat Systems Organization (CSO) concept. The first test of this organization came on 12 December during a four hour NORAD off the Southern California Coast. The high degree of coordination attained between the onboard CSO component parts and the Navy and Army in support of the NORAD/ADC mission was evidenced by CHICAGO scoring eleven "first kills."
