

2. Organization. The Battalion shall be divided by Companies as shown in Appendix I (Training Syllabus) for the training, but the normal Battalion organization will remain into . for all other functions.

3. Responsibilities.

- a. The "A" Company Commander shall arrange for and coordinate all Battalion transportation. Transportation will be provided so that the class schedules lister in Appendix I to this Annex can be maintained. Additional transportation requirements will be coordinated with 1/6.
- b. Company Commanders are responsible for having all Company personnel at the place of instruction at the designated times shown in Appendix I.
- c. The S-1; is responsible for arranging for meals and/or providing box lunches or C rations for Battalion personnel in accordance with the training schedule. Commuted rations will be checked during this deployment.
- d. The S-2 is responsible for overall co-ordination of the training effort while at Carp Lejeune. In addition, the S-2 will publish weekly training schedules and those items published separately from this OPCRD.
- e. The 3-2 will distribute to all Company Commenders the quotas granted to 1937 for personnel to attend specialized courses, as well as the number of teams and personnel required to man crew-served weapons. Company Commenders shall provide 3-2 rosters of personnel attending designated schools.
- f. The Medical Officer shall detail ! field medic per commy to undergo training and provide medical support. These field medics will be equipped with standard Unit 1 kits.
- g. The S-3 will develop a grading system for Company standings in the Color Company competition, coordinating results from TD reports.
 - h. Additional responsibilities are defined throughout this OPOND.

4. Coordinating Instructions.

- a. The senior officer or petty officer present from each Company shall insure that all training areas/locations are properly policed before securing from any unit exercise or function.
- b. Insofar as possible, Company Commanders and Company Chiefs will undergo training with their Companies.
- c. The military training instructors are responsible only for administering periods of instruction.
