### Key engagement

Pursuit of common interests in multilateral fora, particularly the UN and the Commonwealth.

### Outlook

Trade and investment opportunities exist in Saint Lucia for Australian businesses, including in transport, tourism and related industries.

### Bilateral relations

Australia and Saint Lucia established diplomatic relations in 1982.

Australia's High Commissioner to Trinidad and Tobago has non-resident accreditation to Saint Lucia.

Saint Lucia does not have official representation in Australia.

### Foreign relations

Australia and Saint Lucia are members of the Commonwealth, World Trade Organisation (WTO) and United Nations (UN).

Saint Lucia is a member of the the Caribbean Community (CARICOM), the Association of Caribbean States (ACS), the African, Caribbean and Pacific (ACP) Group of States, the Organization of American States (OAS) and other regional organisations.

It is a member of the Small Island Developing States (SIDS) grouping, which includes small island states in the Caribbean, Pacific and Indian Oceans.

### **Public diplomacy**

Through the <u>Direct Aid Program</u> (DAP), the Australian Government provides financial support to a range of projects in Saint Lucia. Recent DAP projects include providing improved access to clean potable water and water storage facilities in rural communities.

The Australian men's cricket team visited Saint Lucia for its first cricket tour of the West Indies in six years in early July 2021.

## **Economic diplomacy**

The Australian Government assists Australian investors in Saint Lucia by providing support and advice on political, economic and regulatory environments.
