Personalization

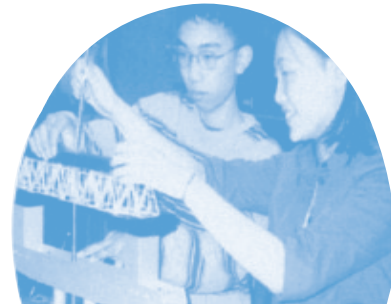

International Baccalaureate

Academy of Information Technology
