One of the Most Outstanding Congressmen – 1989-1998

Recipient and Awardee – Municipal Mayor’s League of the Philippines Philippine Chamber of Health for his outstanding achievement as one of the principal proponent of R.A. 7162 otherwise known as the “New Local Government Code of the Philippines.”

Appointed as the House of Representative’s Chairman of Book II (Tax and Fiscal Matters) and Sub-Committee Chairman, Bicameral Conference Committee in the drafting of the Local Government Code of 1991.

Endorsed unanimously by 17 Congressman from Region IV as Chairman of the Regional Development of Council-Region VI in 1992

## **AUTHORED AND SPOSORED LEGISLATIONS**

R.A. NO. 8424 – The Tax Reform Act of 1997 which exempts the income of overseas workers and increase the personal and additional exemptions of wage earners.

R.A. NO. 8241 – The amendments of the Expanded Value Added Tax Law which exempt among others Agricultural Products and Cooperatives from the Value Added Tax.

R.A. NO. 8240 – The Excise Tax Reform Act which shifts the Excise Tax on “Sin Products” to Specific Tax.

R.A. NO. 8184 – The amendments of the Excise Tax on Oil Products which shifts the Ad Valorem duty on Oil Products to Specific Tax.

R.A. NO. 7653 – The New Central Bank act which restructures the Bangko Sentral ng Pilipinas

The Local Government Code, specifically BOOK II relating to Fiscal Matters, which grants Internal Revenue Allotment (IRA) to provinces, cities, municipalities and barangays and provides for Honorarium to Barangay Officials.
