Unincorporated Broward County, 2006

Effective September 2006, the Unincorporated Area will be only 10.4 square miles and less than one percent of County residents will live in unincorporated neighborhoods.

Effective September 15, 2006, the Unincorporated Area will be 10.4 square miles with an estimated population of approximately $14,190^{1}$, which is less than one percent of Broward County's total population. The Unincorporated Area will include:

• **5.8 square miles of Regional Facilities** (three landfills/resource recovery plants and Fort Lauderdale-Hollywood International Airport) that are to remain unincorporated;

• 1.1 square miles of Right of Way; and,


• **3.5 square miles that have not been annexed:** made up of four Central County neighborhoods, Broadview Park, Hillsboro Pines/Ranches, several enclaves.




