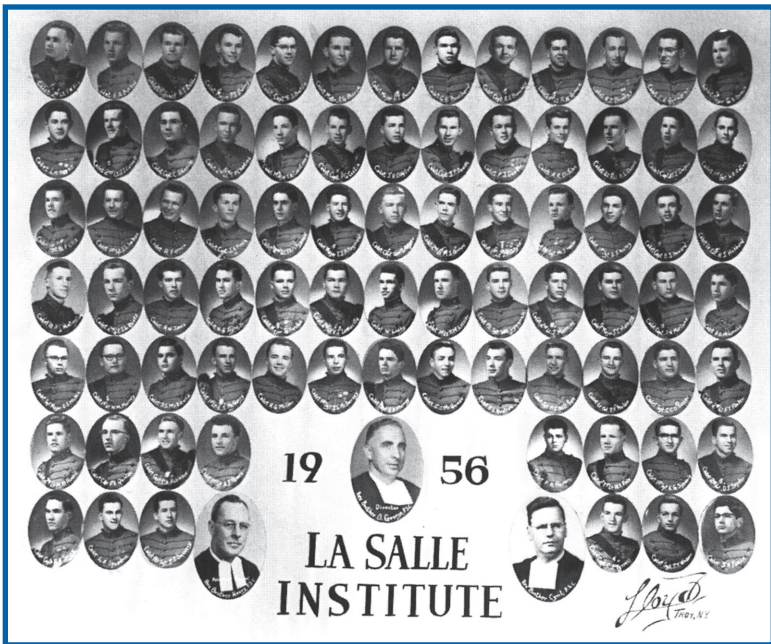

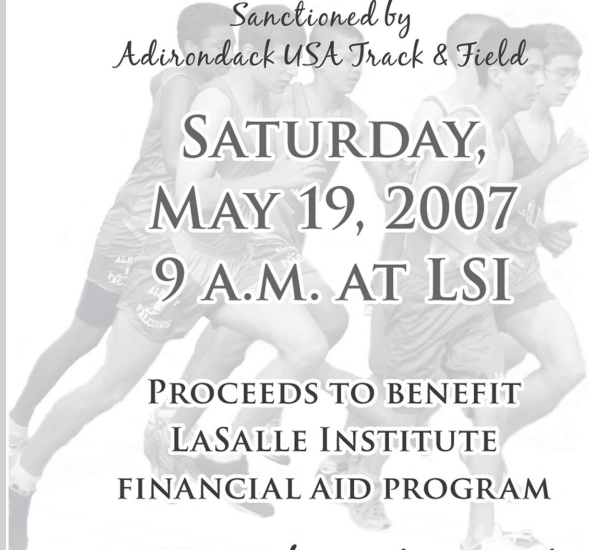

*“An experience to remember with friends
in the heart of Boston, MA”*

After 3 years at La Salle Providence, I was transferred to the Boston area. I began 8 grand years at a rinky-dink parish high school. Rinky-dink or not, I loved it. Almost over night, I found 2 friends at school. Bill Lally, nephew of our famous Provincial and his friend from the Harvard Square area, Dan Cronin. They bought 3 tickets for a Boston Bruins hockey game and of course Brother John must go with them. In my rather new black suit and topcoat I took the train from Waltham to the North Station, where they both met me. They had taken the subway from Harvard Square. We three then went upstairs (mind you) for a great Bruins game!

After the game at 11:15 Bill Lally made me visit his place of employment in the heart of Boston downtown. So off we go through Scollay Square {regarded by sailors as worse than Singapore}.
