1. (U) Introduction

(U) The Administrative Review Board (ARB) determined ISN 675 continues to be threat to the United States and its allies. In reaching this determination, the ARB considered both classified and unclassified information. The following is an account of the proceedings and the factors the ARB used in making its recommendation.

2. (U) Synopsis of Proceedings

- (U) The Enemy Combatant (EC) declined to attend the ARB; consequently the board was convened and conducted its proceedings without the EC being present. The Designated Military Officer (DMO) presented the unclassified summary, both in a written form and with an oral summary of the unclassified primary factors.
- (U) The Assisting Military Officer (AMO) presented the Enemy Combatant Notification as Exhibit EC-A, identified herein as enclosure (2). The AMO then presented the Enemy Combatant Election Form as Exhibit EC-B, identified herein as enclosure (3). Exhibit EC-B indicated that the EC chose not to participate. When asked why, the EC stated "From my experience, looking at the other detainees, I don't see any difference". The EC further stated, "Honestly, I don't want to participate and looking more at the evidence, you have added more than was said at the CSRT. If you are looking at the future, why are these allegations based on my past?" In response to 4.c in the unclassified summary the EC agreed he was really just a criminal and not a terrorist. The EC wanted the assistance of the AMO and requested that the AMO give his responses at the ARB, point-by-point, to the Unclassified Summary of Evidence. The AMO verbally summarized the EC's comments during the interview. The comments above are excerpts from enclosure (3).
- (U) The unclassified portion of the proceeding was adjourned. The ARB moved to the classified session and the DMO presented the classified summary. The ARB panel members reviewed the classified exhibits and the session was then closed for deliberation.




c. (U) <u>Crime, Combat and Capture</u>. The EC was captured in connection with the conduct of combat or terrorist operations against the United States and its allies. The EC is an experienced soldier and participated in combat operations linked with the global terrorist network. Additionally, the EC has provided logistical support for known terrorist groups.



 - (U) The IMU is a coalition of Islamic militants from Uzbekistan and other Central Asian states opposed to Uzbekistani President Islom Karimov's secular regime. Although the IMU's primary goal remains to overthrow Karimov and establish an Islamic state in Uzbekistan, IMU political and ideological leader Tohir Yoldashev is working to rebuild the organization and appears to have widened the IMU's targets to include all those he perceives as fighting Islam. The IMU generally has been unable to operate in Uzbekistan and thus has been more active in Kyrgyzstan and Tajikistan. (DMO-3)




(U) The Administrative Review Board (ARB) determined ISN 701 continues to be a threat to the United States and its allies. In reaching this determination, the ARB considered both classified and unclassified information. The following is an account of the proceedings and the factors the ARB used in making its determination.

2. (U) Synopsis of Proceedings

(U) The ARB was convened and began its proceedings with the Enemy Combatant (EC) present. The Designated Military Officer (DMO) presented the unclassified summary, both in written form and with an oral summary of the unclassified primary factors. The Assisting Military Officer (AMO) presented the Enemy Combatant Notification as exhibit EC-A and the Enemy Combatant Election Form indicating the EC elected to participate, documented as exhibit EC-B. The AMO stated the EC has a lawyer who advised him against answering any questions. The EC gave a verbal statement stating his plans should he be released, that he is not a threat to the U.S., he has matured, and holds no grudge; this is detailed in Enclosure (5). The unclassified part of the proceeding was adjourned. The ARB moved to the classified portion of the session and the DMO presented the classified summary. The ARB members had no questions during the classified portion of the ARB. The session was then closed for deliberation.

(U) The Administrative Review Board (ARB) determined ISN 709 continues to be a threat to the United States and its allies. In reaching this determination, the ARB considered both classified and unclassified information. The following is an account of the proceedings and the factors the ARB used in making its determination.

2. (U) Synopsis of Proceedings

(U) The ARB was convened and began its proceedings without the Enemy Combatant (EC) present. The Designated Military Officer (DMO) presented the unclassified summary, both in written form and with an oral summary of the unclassified primary factors. The Assisting Military Officer (AMO) presented the Enemy Combatant Notification as Exhibit EC-A, identified herein as Enclosure (2). The AMO also presented the Enemy Combatant Election Form as Exhibit EC-B, identified herein as Enclosure (3). Exhibit EC-B indicates the EC wanted the assistance of the Assisting Military Officer but chose to decline to participate or appear at his ARB. The EC indicated he did not want to appear due to the fact that he would not feel comfortable in a courtroom-like setting. The AMO read the EC's comments from Exhibit EC-B that denied and/or qualified the information contained in the unclassified summary. The EC prepared a written statement that the AMO read to the board and submitted as Exhibit EC-C, identified herein as Enclosure (4). The EC said he is afraid to go back to Libya and feels that if he is sent back to Libya he would be sent to prison. The EC indicated he would feel better if released in the U.S. to return to Libya on his own as opposed to being transferred to Libya directly Enclosure (6). In his written statement the EC denied and/or qualified the information contained in the unclassified summary. The board asked questions to further clarify the information in the unclassified summary. The unclassified part of the proceeding was adjourned. The ARB moved to the classified portion of the session and the DMO presented the classified summary. ARB members had clarification questions that were answered satisfactorily. The session was then closed for deliberation.
