Oyster continues to be the easiest way to travel around London:

- Adult cash bus and tram single fares cost £2 but with Oyster cost 90p
- Adult cash Tube single fares within Zone 1 cost £4 but with Oyster cost £1.50
- The daily price cap for unlimited travel on bus, Tube, tram, DLR, London Overground and National Rail services where pay as you go is accepted is cheaper than the cost of the equivalent Day Travelcard
- The Oyster single fare for 11-15s on the Tube, DLR and London Overground is 50p, with a daily price cap of £1 for unlimited travel all day within Zones 1-6
- Oyster pay as you go is valid on more National Rail routes – check at tfl.gov.uk/fares or with your operator before you travel
- The number of Oyster Ticket Stops has been increased to make it even easier to top-up your pay as you go credit and add season tickets to your Oyster

Choose the right Oyster option for you

Travelling once or twice a month and paying cash? Get Oyster pay as you go

Oyster pay as you go lets you store credit on your Oyster allowing you to pay for single journeys as you go and can save you money.

Also, daily price capping on Oyster pay as you go means that no matter how much you travel in one day (0430 and before 0430 the next day), you'll never pay more than the cost of an equivalent Day Travelcard or Bus Pass. Our aim is to ensure

that Oyster always charges the lowest fare. Where it doesn't we will refund the difference.

Topping up your Oyster is easy. You can top-up your pay as you go credit at Oyster Ticket Stops, online as well as at the Tube and London Overground stations.

Travelling about three times a week? Get Oyster pay as you go or set up Auto top-up

Using Oyster pay as you go can still save you money, as well as avoiding the need to queue for a paper ticket every time.

Better still, set up Auto top-up to ensure your Oyster card never runs out of credit. Auto top-up automatically tops-up your card whenever your balance falls below £5. Visit tfl.gov.uk/oyster for full details and to set up Auto top-up.

Travelling every day?

Add a Travelcard to your Oyster

For everyday users, 7 Day, Monthly or longer period Travelcard season tickets can be stored on your Oyster. Travelcards can be used for unlimited journeys within the zones paid for, including most National Rail services in London. You can add a Travelcard to your Oyster at Oyster Ticket Stops, Tube and London Overground stations.

Travelling outside your Travelcard zones?

Add pay as you go credit to your Oyster

Oyster cards are designed to be flexible. If you need to make journeys outside the zones in which your Travelcard is valid, you can add credit to your Oyster card and use it to pay as you go. Your journey must be made entirely on routes where pay as you go is accepted.

Want to protect your credit and season ticket on your Oyster? Register your card

To ensure the credit or tickets on your Oyster card are protected if your card is lost or stolen, register it at an Oyster Ticket Stop, or at Tube and London Overground stations.

To ensure you pay the correct Oyster single fare, when travelling by Tube, DLR, London Overground and some National Rail services where pay as you go is accepted, you must always touch in on the yellow reader at the start and touch out at the end of your journey.

When using the bus or tram, you must touch in at the start but not at the end of your journey.

Please check for the green light when you touch in or touch out on the yellow reader to ensure your Oyster card has been validated. If you continue to get a red light, ask a member of staff for advice.

If you don't touch in at the start and touch out at the end of your journey with your Oyster card when using the Tube, DLR, London Overground or National Rail services, even if the gates are open, you will pay a maximum cash fare. This will not count towards your daily price cap.

If you do not hold a valid ticket or validated Oyster card when paying as you go for any part of your journey, you will be liable to a Penalty fare or may be prosecuted.

Travel discounts

There are some great travel discounts available which are listed briefly below. For full terms and conditions visit tfl.gov.uk/fares or pick up a leaflet at most Tube, London Overground stations and Oyster Ticket Stops.

Under 11s travel free

- Children under 5 can travel free anywhere on the bus, Tube, tram, DLR and London Overground at any time when accompanied by an adult with a valid ticket, validated Oyster card or freedom pass
- 5-10 year olds can travel free on the bus and tram

- 5-10 year olds can travel free on the Tube, DLR and London Overground with a 5-10 Oyster photocard. No photocard is needed if accompanied by an adult with a valid ticket, validated Oyster card or freedom pass

Travel for 11-15 year olds

- Free travel on the bus and tram with an Oyster photocard
- Child-rate Travelcard season tickets or pay as you go at child-rate on the Tube, DLR and London Overground with an Oyster photocard

Travel for 16-19 year olds

- Free travel on the bus and tram if living in London and in full-time education, or on a work-based learning scheme, plus half adult-rate on the Tube, DLR and London Overground – a valid 16+ Oyster photocard is needed
- Half adult-rate on the bus, Tube, tram, DLR and London Overground for other 16-17 year olds with a valid 16+ Oyster photocard

Travel for 18+ students in full-time education

30% discount on adult-rate Bus Pass and Travelcard season tickets with an 18+ Student Oyster photocard if you are attending a college or school registered with TfL.

Bus and Tram Discount Card for Londoners on Income Support

The scheme is now closed to new applicants. Existing cards will continue to be valid until their expiry date.

New Deal photocard

Holders of a New Deal photocard get child-rate Tube, DLR and London Overground tickets (including Travelcards), reduced-rate Bus Passes and can use Oyster to pay as you go at half the adult-rate. For season tickets and to pay as you go, you will need an Oyster card and get your New Deal discount concession loaded on to it.

There are a number of places to buy tickets, get Oyster cards and top them up including:

- Oyster Ticket Stops*
- Online at tfl.gov.uk/oyster
- Tube and London Overground touchscreen ticket machines and ticket offices
- Self service ticket machines at DLR stations (not Oyster cards)
- Some National Rail station ticket offices
- London Travel Information Centres

Using Tube, DLR, London Overground and National Rail services

Tube/DLR, London Overground and National Rail services in London are mainly divided into six zones. The Tube/London Overground also operates outside Zones 1-6, serving the following stations:

Zone 7: Carpenders Park, Chorleywood, Croxley, Rickmansworth and Watford (Metropolitan line)

Zone 8: Bushey, Chalfont & Latimer and Watford High Street

Zone 9: Amersham and Chesham

Special fares apply for journeys to/from Watford Junction

DLR services operate within Zones 1, 2 and 3.

The following can be used on Tube, DLR, London Overground and some National Rail services:

- Oyster pay as you go
- Cash single tickets
- Travelcards

Travelcards must be valid for all the zones travelled in; the cost will depend on the number of zones it covers.

Using bus and tram services only

The following can be used on buses and trams:

- Oyster pay as you go
- Cash single tickets
- Bus Saver
- Bus Passes
- Travelcards

Bus and tram

The fares below apply on all London’s buses displaying this sign: and on trams.



Wheelchair users can travel free on buses and trams.

Cash single fares are not available on buses in the Pay Before You Board area in central London, on bendy buses or on route W7. Before boarding, you must have enough credit on your Oyster card to pay as you go or have a valid ticket.

Bus Saver

Bus Saver tickets are no longer available to buy. Oyster single fares are cheaper at 90p a trip on Oyster. However, you can continue to use any bus Saver tickets you may have.

When using bus Saver tickets you must board at the front door of the bus, give the Staff receipt part only of the ticket to the driver (on buses on heritage routes 9 and 15 with a conductor, board the bus and give the Staff receipt part only of the ticket to the conductor) and retain the top part.

Tube, DLR and London Overground

The following tables show Oyster single fares within Zones 1-6 on the Tube, DLR and London Overground.

Cash single fares are shown for:

- Tube and DLR
- Journeys from the Tube and DLR to London Overground

For fares that include travel in Zones 7-9 plus Watford Junction the leaflet 'Your guide to fares and tickets (Zones 7-9 plus Watford Junction)' is available at tfl.gov.uk or pick up a copy at a Tube or London Overground station in Zones 7-9.

Single fares on London Overground

Special cash single fares apply for journeys wholly on London Overground; please ask at your local station for details.

Special Oyster single fares apply for local journeys on London Overground between Euston (National Rail) and Watford Junction and intermediate stations in Zones 2-6; please see pages 14-15.

On the tables on pages 11-13 (except for Child), the higher Oyster single fares apply for local journeys on London Overground between Euston (National Rail) and Watford Junction and intermediate stations in Zones 2-6 as follows:

Towards Euston: Monday to Friday from 0700 and before 0930.

Away from Euston: Monday to Friday from 1600 and before 1900.

Oyster single fares on London Overground between Euston and Watford Junction

Special Oyster single fares apply for local journeys on London Overground between Euston (National Rail) and Watford Junction and intermediate stations in Zones 2-6.

Peak Oyster single fares apply as follows:

Towards Euston: Monday to Friday from 0700 and before 0930.

Away from Euston: Monday to Friday from 1600 and before 1900.

Off-Peak Oyster single fares apply at all other times.

Please note that the fare charged is determined by the time at which you touch your card on the yellow reader at the start of your journey.

For example if you plan to catch a train that leaves Euston after 1900, but touch in before 1900, you will be charged the Peak Oyster single fare.

Oyster daily price capping

The daily price cap is the most you will be charged a day when you pay as you go on bus, Tube, tram, DLR, London Overground and some National Rail services. If you use buses and trams only, the bus daily price cap will apply.

Our aim is to ensure that Oyster always charges the lowest fare. Where it doesn't we will refund the difference.

To ensure you get charged the lowest fares, you must always touch in at the start and touch out at the end of every journey on Tube, DLR, London Overground and some National Rail services. On bus and tram services you must touch in at the start of each journey,

The appropriate **Off-Peak daily price cap** will apply if you make several journeys on bus, Tube, tram, DLR, London Overground and some National Rail services on the same day during the following hours:

- Monday to Friday: for all journeys that start after 0930 and before 0430 the following day
- Saturday, Sunday and public holidays: from 0430 for all journeys that start before 0430 the following day

The appropriate **Peak daily price cap** will apply if you travel from 0430 and before 0930 Monday to Friday.

If the total cost for your journeys is less than the Peak daily price cap, you will be charged for each journey you make from 0430 and before 0930 (Monday to Friday excluding public holidays), plus the cheaper of the Off-Peak Oyster single fares/Off-Peak daily price cap for the remainder of your journeys.

Even though there is a flat fare on buses and trams, if you also use Tube, DLR, London Overground and some National Rail services during the same day, any journeys made from 0430 and before 0930 (Monday to Friday, excluding public holidays) will mean that a Peak daily price cap will be applied (or an Anytime Day Travelcard is needed).

Some journeys are defined as requiring travel via Zone 1 and will be charged and capped accordingly, irrespective of the actual route taken.

NOTE: if you intend to use National Rail services, a Day Travelcard may be a better option as pay as you go is only available on some National Rail routes.

One day tickets

Unlimited daily travel on our services is available using Day Travelcards, Group Day Tickets and One Day Bus Passes.

If you use bus, Tube, tram, DLR or London Overground services in one day, an Anytime Day Travelcard is needed if travelling before 0930 Monday to Friday (excluding public holidays).

If you have an Oyster card, you can use it to pay as you go and your total daily travel will be capped at less than the price of an equivalent Day Travelcard or, if using buses and trams only, a One Day Bus Pass; please see pages 18 to 22.

Season tickets are available for 7 days, one month or any longer period up to one year.

Bus Passes can be used on all London's buses and trams.

Travelcards can be used on the Tube, DLR, London Overground and National Rail† within the zones covered by your ticket and on all London buses displaying this sign:



They also include a 1/3 discount off scheduled Riverboat services.

Any Travelcard covering Zones 3, 4, 5, or 6 is valid on trams.

Travelcard season tickets which are valid for longer than one month, except annuals, are priced accordingly.

The following can only be issued for the following maximum periods:

- 4 months: child-rate (including Bus and Tram Discount)
- 3 months: New Deal

Tram feeder bus services

Valid tram cash single tickets can also be used for onward travel, via any interchange point in the Addington area, on tram feeder bus services. Tram cash single tickets can also be bought on tram feeder bus services for inclusive travel on trams via any interchange point in the Addington area.

If you use the tram to or from Wimbledon

When travelling to Wimbledon by tram, always touch in at the start of your journey and touch out at the gates when leaving the station. When travelling from Wimbledon by tram, always touch in at the ticket gates when entering the station and again at the yellow readers on the tram platform before boarding. Do not use the yellow reader next to the manual gate when exiting the station.

London Overground

London Overground operates the following routes:

- Gospel Oak to Barking
- Richmond to Stratford
- Watford Junction to Euston
- Willesden Junction to Clapham Junction

You can use Oyster to pay as you go on all London Overground services.

For more details and information about cash single fares on London Overground, ask at your local London Overground station or visit tfl.gov.uk/fares

Note: Extensive engineering works are happening on these routes between 1 September and 16 November 2008. Please check before purchasing your ticket at tfl.gov.uk/overground

Oyster single fares on National Rail
