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SPERRY GYROSCOPE

In 1939 Sperry Gyroscope was inundated with orders for military gyrocompasses from all the allied nations. In '39 and '40 the U.S. government saw the Second World War coming and built the Lake Success Complex to house the gigantic war effort of the Sperry Gyroscope Company. The \$40,000,000.00, 1.4 million square foot, complex was occupied by 22,000 Sperry employees for the duration of the war. During that time, the number of Sperry Gyroscope employees increased by five fold. Their productivity increased ten fold. The Sperry Gyroscope contribution to the war effort was invaluable.

UNITED NATIONS

In 1946, while the headquarters of the United Nations was being built on the East River in Manhattan, the Sperry Lake Success facility became the first headquarters of the new United Nations. The facility had parking, office space, meeting rooms, technical support and everything needed to enhance the process of world diplomacy.

UNISYS CORP.

The Sperry and the Burroughs Corporations merged to form Unisys. The Lake Success complex, which had always been state-of-the-art was going even higher tech. Unisys focused on the computer market and in the Aerospace and Marine Industries.

LORAL CORP.

In 1995 the Loral Corporation acquired the Lake Success property. Loral Defense Systems-East was responsible for the design, development, integration and support of advanced navigation systems in U.S. Navy ballistic missile submarines. The electronic and systems integration businesses of Loral were the primary focus of Lockheed Martin's operation, developing navigation systems for the Navy's Trident nuclear submarine.

In 2000 National RE/sources acquired the 94-acre Lake Success property from Lockheed Martin. In partnership with Apollo Real Estate Funds, National RE/sources began the transformation of the former defense plant into i.park Lake Success. They put a \$100 million capital improvement program in place to make i.park Lake Success into a modern, multi-tenant business campus for office, back office and flex users.
