Feingold leads Thompson

Raleigh, N.C. – Russ Feingold leads Tommy Thompson 47-44 in a hypothetical contest for the US Senate, representing a tightening since Feingold led 50-41 in a November PPP survey of the race.

The tightening is largely due to movement among Republicans. In the previous survey Feingold had a 47-41 lead with them but now Thompson is up 45-40. That shift is reflective of the national landscape, as independents are leaning toward the GOP in generic ballot polling and most individual races across the country.

Feingold's approval rating is 45%, unchanged from the November survey. 41% of voters disapprove of him. He's very popular with Democrats, sporting a 73% approval rating, and equally unpopular with Republicans, 71% of whom disapprove of him. Independents narrowly give him good marks, 46/43.

Thompson is not all that popular, with more voters viewing him unfavorably (44%) than favorably (40%). Those numbers are pretty similar to where they stood in November, which was 38/45. Just like Feingold, Thompson is very polarizing with 70% of Republicans seeing him favorably and 73% of Democrats holding a negative opinion of him.

Thompson will have to run for Republicans to make a race of it here. Feingold leads Terrence Wall 48-34 and Dave Westlake 48-31. Wall has 21% name recognition and Westlake's is only 11%.

"This clearly would be a competitive race if Tommy Thompson decides to run," said Dean Debnam, President of Public Policy Polling. "Otherwise Feingold should be safe for reelection."

PPP surveyed 700 Wisconsin voters on March 20^{th} and 21^{st} . The margin of error for the survey is +/-3.7%. Other factors, such as refusal to be interviewed and weighting, may introduce additional error that is more difficult to quantify.
