

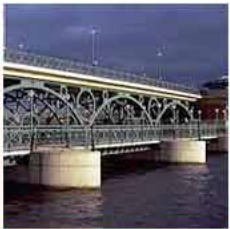

Key SMI project:

- To upgrade the course
- To put in place enhanced management
- To attract other investment



A £3.4m course upgrade proposed:

Funding from

•ONE	£2.47m
•Sport England	£0.50m
•British Waterways	£0.35m
•Councils	£0.10m
Total	£3.42m



In addition:

- New canoe storage building - £206k
- Sport England revenue support for 3 years - £210k



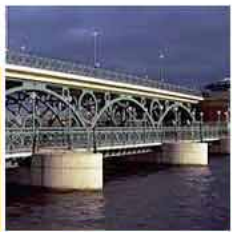
Course upgrade comprises:

- Reconfigure course
- Create new short cut course
- Install pumps to create flow when required
- Generate electricity when possible
