Bachman also recovered a fumble on Campbell's first drive of the second half, setting up Morehead State's go-ahead field goal.

Junior, Kicker, Gibsonville, N.C. Willets finished with six points in Campbell's 30-24 double-overtime loss at Morehead State, Saturday. He scored three extra points and kicked a 27-yard field goal that gave the Camels a 17-10 lead with four minutes remaining. Willets tied his own school record with his season's ninth field goal. He also handled kickoff
