# February 2009 Nevada Gaming Revenues and Collections

### Win Revenue Summary - February 2009

Nevada's nonrestricted gaming licensees reported a total "gaming win" of \$830,945,792 for the month of February 2009. This amounts to an 18.12% <u>decrease</u> compared to February 2008, when licensees reported a gaming win of \$1,014,840,035. For the fiscal year (July 1, 2008 through February 28, 2009), gaming win has decreased 14.53%.

## Percentage Fee Collections for the Month of March 2009

The State collected \$65,061,217 in percentage fees during the month of March 2009, based upon the taxable revenues generated in February 2009. This represents a 22.60% (or \$11,992,508) increase compared to the prior year's March, when percentage fee collections were \$53,068,916.
