PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Nate Wolters (South Dakota State), 26.0 ppg, 6.5 apg, 4.5 rpg, 2.0 spg, 61.1% FG, 85.7% FT, 6.5 asst/to ratio

SUMMIT (SNEAK) PEEKS

A rundown of this week's essential "need to know" information about The Summit League:

> **The Summit League** features the NCAA's active career scoring leader (IUPUI's **Alex Young**), current season scoring leader (OU's **Reggie Hamilton**), and only player averaging 20 ppg, 6 apg and 5 rpg (SDSU's **Nate Wolters**).

> With three players (OU's Reggie Hamilton, ORU's Dominique Morrison and SDSU's Nate Wolters) on the finalists list for the Lou Henson Award (Mid-Major Player of the Year), **The Summit League** has the highest total of any league.

> **The Summit League** was one of only two leagues with multiple participating teams to post perfect records in nationally-televised BracketBuster games.

> Two **Summit League** teams (45. ORU, 61. SDSU) are among the top 68 in the Feb. 20 NCAA RPI rankings. On Feb. 21, The Summit League ranked No. 17 in the *Collegiate Basketball News* RPI (rpiratings.com).

> **Oral Roberts** climbed to No. 11 with one first-place vote while **South Dakota State** re-entered the rankings at No. 23 in this week's Mid-Major Top 25.

> **The Summit League** recorded a winning percentage of .500 or better against 15 of the 17 mid-major conferences its teams have played this season.

> 60 percent of the NCAA's top five career scoring leaders, 40 percent of the nation's top 10 scorers this season and 28 percent of Division I players averaging 20 ppg come from **The Summit League**, the most of any league for each category.

> **The Summit League** has shattered its previous best marks for highest season winning percentage on record (since 1998-99) against both Division I competition and all non-league competition.

> Seven of the NCAA's 32 scoring performances of 37 points or more this season have been achieved by **Summit League** players, including three of the 12 40-point games.

NOTEWORTHY

ELITE STATUS

South Dakota State's **Nate Wolters** is the only NCAA player this season averaging 20 points, six assists and five rebounds per game. If he maintains that pace, Wolters will become just the fifth player in NCAA history to achieve those three averages in the same season.

OFFENSIVE TO MANY

The Summit League features the most significant collection of scorers in the nation. IUPUI's **Alex Young** is the NCAA active career scoring leader with 2,239. Oakland's **Reggie Hamilton** is the NCAA's leading scorer this season at 25.1 ppg. Furthermore, Young, Hamilton and Oral Roberts' **Dominique Morrison** all rank among the NCAA's top five active career scoring leaders, giving The Summit League a majority hold. In addition, five of the 18 (28 percent) Division I players who average 20 ppg this season reside in The Summit League with Hamilton, South Dakota State's **Nate Wolters** (6th), Young, and IPFW's **Frank Gaines** (10th) in the top 10.

SIGNIFICANT POINTS

IUPUI's **Alex Young** and Oakland's **Reggie Hamilton** have each scored 40-plus points in games this season. Young poured in 43 points in a Dec. 10 win over Western Kentucky, marking the nation's highest-scoring game for nearly a month Hamilton tallied 41, including the game-winning shot at the buzzer, one week later in a Dec. 17 victory at Valparaiso, the first of two 40-point outings this season. To date, there have been seven 37-plus scoring performances, accounting for nearly 25 percent of the NCAA total, recorded by five different Summit League players this season:

THREE'S COMPANY FOR MID-MAJOR POY

Three Summit League players, more than any other league, were named as finalists for the Lou Henson Award (Mid-Major Player of the Year). Oakland's **Reggie Hamilton**, Oral Roberts' **Dominique Morrison** and South Dakota State's **Nate Wolters** were included in the list of 25 released on Feb. 17. Fans can participate in the award's selection at www.votelouhenson.com. Oral Roberts' **Steven Roundtree** was named as Mid-Major Freshman of the Year last season and former Oakland standout **Keith Benson** claimed the Lou Henson Award in 2009-10.

OH, WHAT A NIGHT

On December 18, for the first time in The Summit League's history, teams defeated both a nationally-ranked opponent and a "power conference" opponent in separate games on the same day. **Oral Roberts** routed No. 8 Xavier, 64-42, marking the largest margin of victory by a Summit League team over a ranked opponent and the fourth-highest ranked opponent ever defeated by a Summit League team. The Golden Eagles also handed Xavier its worst loss in Cintas Center history (opened in 2000-01). Hours later, **South Dakota State** rolled to a 92-73 victory at Washington, claiming its first win over a Pac-12 opponent and snapping the Huskies' 32-game non-conference home court winning streak.

SEE THE SUMMIT ON THE SMALL SCREEN

For the first time in Summit League history, all of its tournament games will be available via national cable television. Fox College Sports, in conjunction with Midco Sports Network, will air the league's 2012 men's and women's quarterfinals and semifinals. ESPN2 will televise

the men's championship game with ESPNU broadcasting the women's title game. Earlier this season, both Oakland and South Dakota State hosted the first nationally-televised basketball games from their on-campus arena.

SHOT ON THE MARK FOR PLAY OF THE YEAR

The full-court buzzer beating game-winning shot by Oral Roberts' **Damen Bell-Holter** Dec. 12 at UALR was selected as a finalist for the GEICO Play of the Year. Bell-Holter intercepted an inbound pass from UALR, dribbled and heaved a 65-foot game-winner as the buzzer sounded to lift ORU to a 58-55 victory. Eight finalists will compete in fan voting later this season with the overall winner announced as part of the *GEICO Best of College Basketball* Special March 25 at 1 p.m. ET on CBS. DOUBLE VISION

Oakland's Nov. 28 victory over Tennessee marked just the third time that a Summit League team has defeated the same opponent from a "power six" conference in consecutive seasons. The Golden Grizzlies also accomplished the feat against Oregon during the 2007-08 and 2008-09 seasons while Missouri State completed the task against Kansas State in 1987-88 and 1988-89.

FOREIGN EXCHANGE

A total of 14 foreign players are on Summit League rosters this season. **South Dakota** leads the way with five international players on its roster, followed by **UMKC** and **Southern Utah** with two each. Canada is represented with a league-high four players, three of whom hail from the greater Toronto area. Australia has three players and England two with the countries of Brazil, Bulgaria, Cameroon, France and Kosovo also represented.

GOOD THINGS HAPPEN IN THREES

ESPN's Jay Bilas selected Oakland's **Travis Bader** as one of the top three 3-point shooters in college basketball in a preseason ESPN.com feature celebrating the 25th anniversary of the three-point shot in college basketball. Bader connected on 10 treys, the third-most in Summit League history, in a 37-point performance, the nation's highest scoring total off the bench this season, Jan. 26 against South Dakota State. His performance earned him selection as Capital One's Impact Player of the Week.

AROUND THE LEAGUE

IPFW's **Frank Gaines** tied his career-high with 30 points against Eastern Kentucky (2/18). Gaines moved into 10th in career field goals made and fifth in single-season scoring during the week ... **IUPUI** shot better than 60 percent in consecutive games against South Dakota (2/15) and Nicholls State (2/18), marking the first time that has happened in the program's Division I era. **Alex Young** enters the week with 108 double-figure scoring games, including 19 consecutive, and 51 20-plus scoring games in his career ... **Oakland's Reggie Hamilton** scored 30 points vs. Southern Utah (2/15) and 34 at Illinois State (2/18), extending his streak to four consecutive games with 30-plus points ... **Oral Roberts** finished the season unbeaten at home (15-0). ORU's 23-game home winning streak is a Division I school record, is third-best in the nation and tied for third-longest all-time in Summit League history. The Golden Eagles' 25 victories ties for the most under **Scott Sutton** ... **South Dakota's Louie Krogman** enters the week having played every minute of the last six games and seven of the past nine. Krogman scored a career-high 37 points against Texas State (2/18) ... **South Dakota State's** BracketBuster victory over Buffalo (2/18) was the first nationally-televised games from Frost Arena. **Nate Wolters** is the most prolific Division I scorer in SDSU history.

WHAT'S IN A NAME?

The Summit League features the NCAA's most unique collection of one-of-a-kind nicknames among its member institutions. Within U.S. college athletics, four names are exclusively held by Summit League schools: **Mastodons** (IPFW), **Golden Grizzlies** (Oakland), **Jackrabbits** (South Dakota State) and **Fighting Leathernecks** (Western Illinois). In addition, the names **Coyotes** (South Dakota), **Kangaroos** (UMKC) and **Thunderbirds** (Southern Utah) are unique to NCAA Division I athletics.

THE SUMMIT LEAGUE

Celebrating its 30th anniversary season at the Division I level in 2011-12, The Summit League offers 19 championship sports and has a combined enrollment of over 135,000 at 11 universities, five of which are located in the top 76 U.S. media markets (Detroit, Indianapolis, Kansas City, Tulsa and Omaha). Member institutions include: IPFW (Indiana University-Purdue University-Fort Wayne), IUPUI (Indiana University-Purdue University-Indianapolis), UMKC (University of Missouri-Kansas City), the University of Nebraska Omaha (which begins league competition in 2012-13), North Dakota State University, Oakland University, Oral Roberts University, the University of South Dakota, South Dakota State University, Southern Utah University and Western Illinois University. FOOD FIGHT

The 2011-12 Summit League Food Fight is in its fourth season with each school having hosted a food drive at a designated home men's and women's basketball game. The initiative, started by the league's Student-Athlete Advisory Committee (SAAC), raised nearly 40,000 pounds of food in 2010-11, almost doubling the previous year's total. 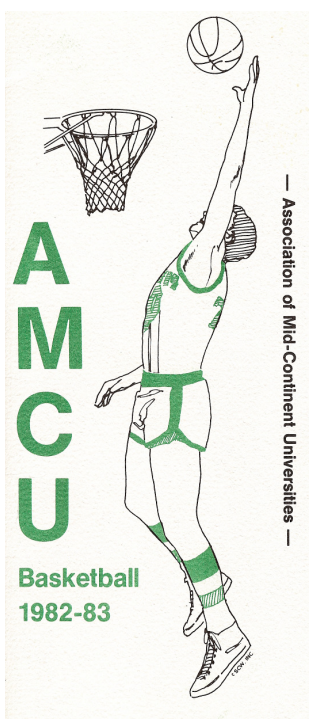
