**To:** Tianjin VTS Centre  
**Giving:** IMO SRS ITEMS: Alpha, Bravo, Golf, India, Oscar, Papa, Quebec, Tango and Uniform.  
**Time limitation:** As required of the competent authority  
**Via:** Agent

**Position reports****Calling in point:**

- (A) Before entering or leaving the Xingang Main Channel;
- (B) Before crossing the Xingang Fairway;
- (C) Before turning around in the Xingang Fairway;
- (D) Before leaving the berth;
- (E) After arriving at the berth;
- (F) Before clearing out of the Lock;
- (G) Before anchoring;
- (H) After anchoring;
- (I) Before departing from the Anchorage.

**To:** Tianjin VTS Centre  
**Giving:** IMO SRS ITEMS: Alpha and Bravo, and name of calling in point  
**Via:** VHF  
**Note:** When efficient communication is not established by VHF, vessels shall report to the VTS Centre by all available means and obtain a confirmation.

**Emergency reports**

Vessels are required to report any traffic accidents, pollution incidents, engine damage, injury of persons and any other emergency situations involved or found.

**VHF PROCEDURES****VTS Centre working channels**

Calling and listening: VHF CH 09  
 Working: VHF CH 65

**Note:**

All ships navigating and anchoring in VTS area shall keep watch on the designated frequency, permission to change frequency or to end VHF watch should be obtained from VTS centre.
