MEMORANDUM FOR: Director of Training

SUBJECT: MKULTRA Drug Experimentation
Subproject 63

1. The Agency is committed to a search for persons who may have suffered lingering aftereffects as a result of their having been participants without their knowledge in drug experimentation sponsored by the Agency many years ago. None of these people are identified in available Agency records, which are skeletal in the extreme. The purpose of this memorandum is to request your assistance in attempting to establish whether records of the Office of Training might reveal that Agency training facilities were ever used for purposes related to drug experimentation.

2. Subproject 63 of the MKULTRA program "served" as a mechanism for reimbursing [REDACTED] for personal services rendered TSS/Chemical Division." Among the services [REDACTED] was to perform was "Participation in and direction of Agency sponsored (internal and external) training exercises and courses in the general area of alcohol and social drinking." [REDACTED] also was engaged in studies to compare the effects of alcohol and LSD as well as the effects of simultaneous or concurrent ingestion of both substances.

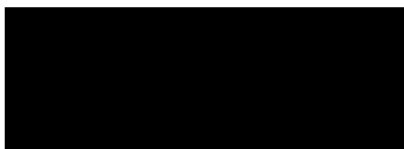
3. The record of subproject 63 reveals that [REDACTED] claimed fees for consulting services, usually including round trip travel expenses between [REDACTED] and Washington on numerous occasions from 1957 through 1961, as follows: May and September 1957; February, April and June 1958; July and September 1960; February, April, July, and October 1961.

We need to know whether records of the Office of Training reveal visits by [redacted] - an associate of [redacted] to Agency train- STATINTL ing facilities under sponsorship of TSS during any of the times mentioned. The record is silent about 1959, but that year should not be overlooked. If you can establish that such visits did, in fact, take place, we need to know everything the record reveals about them, particularly the identities of students and faculty who may have participated.

5. We will appreciate your undertaking the necessary research as expeditiously as possible. Please notify me of the results as soon as you can confidently give your assurance that it has been completed, but not later than 31 October 1978. STATINTL
