

RUNNING L5R EVENTS IS EASY!



Legend of the Five Rings events are perhaps the easiest to run and report to the DCI, given that you only have to report the event's final standings. You will find a master copy of the Final Standings Report Form behind this page. After reading the steps below, please use this form for your first DCI-sanctioned L5R event. An additional copy of this form exists in the DCI Sanctioning & Reporting section at the back of this book. Please make copies of that version for any future events you sanction with the DCI!

L5R Events—Step by Step, from Sanctioning to Reporting

1. Fill out a copy of the Tournament Sanctioning Application.

- Complete the DCI Sanctioning Application.
- The DCI offers a variety of prize kits for L5R events. Be sure to identify which prize kit you'd like for your event.

2. Shortly after sanctioning your event, you will receive:

- an Event Report Summary customized by DCI staff for the event you're scheduling.
Report the final standings of your event on the back of the Event Report Summary—you only need to send in one piece of paper!
- the promo cards and prize certificates with the Event Report Summary; and
- A pad of DCI membership application cards for players who are new to tournaments.

If you ordered a paid prize kit, the additional prize items will arrive separately.

3. Run your tournament in the style you choose, and record the participants' finishing order on the back of the Event Report Summary.

- New players registering for their first sanctioned event must fill out DCI membership applications. They will begin to develop rankings in their favorite games, starting with their participation in this event.

NOTE: Only players who are reported with DCI numbers will count in the calculation of ranking points available for this event. So, if a quarter of the tournament's participants do not report DCI numbers, the event will be worth 25 percent less to the remaining players' rankings.

- * Organizers may run their events using the preferred Swiss pairing method listed in Section F.1 if they choose, or they may run their events double-elimination, single-elimination or any other pairing method that is fair to all participants.

4. Send the completed Event Report Summary back to the DCI.

For each event, please send the following information to the address above:

- A complete Event Report Summary
- A full list of participants, including each player's DCI number and his or her affiliation and final standing in this event
- The membership application cards filled out by each new player attending your event. (The player keeps the tournament-card portion of the application so he or she can build a ranking under one DCI number.)
