- U.S. inventories of propane continued sharply lower last week, down 2.2 million barrels (MMB) to an estimated 47.5 MMB as of week ended December 24, 1999. U.S. inventories remain near the lower limit of the normal range for this time of year. Regional declines in inventories were heaviest in the Midwest and Gulf Coast regions, down 1.0 MMB and 0.8 MMB, respectively, while in the East Coast, inventories reported a more modest decline of 0.3 MMB. Regional inventories remain within or above their respective normal ranges except in the Gulf Coast region where inventories continue below the normal range.
- Residential propane prices were up slightly for the December 20, 1999 report period. The 100.7 cents per gallon price reflected a 1.1-cent increase over the last report period two weeks ago. Wholesale propane prices were flat with the 44.4 cents per gallon price, unchanged from its December 6, 1999 level. Contrasted with one year ago, the residential price was up 12.7 cents from December 21, 1998, which stood at 88.0 cents per gallon, while the wholesale price increased 19.3 cents from its year-ago price of 25.1 cents per gallon.
