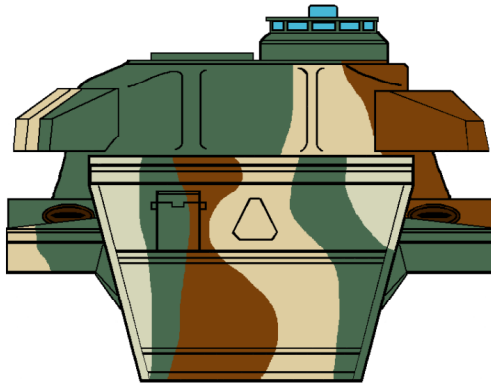
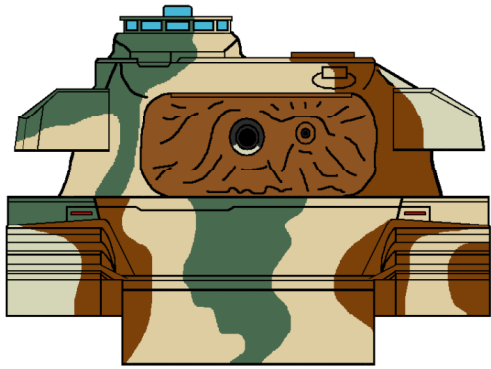
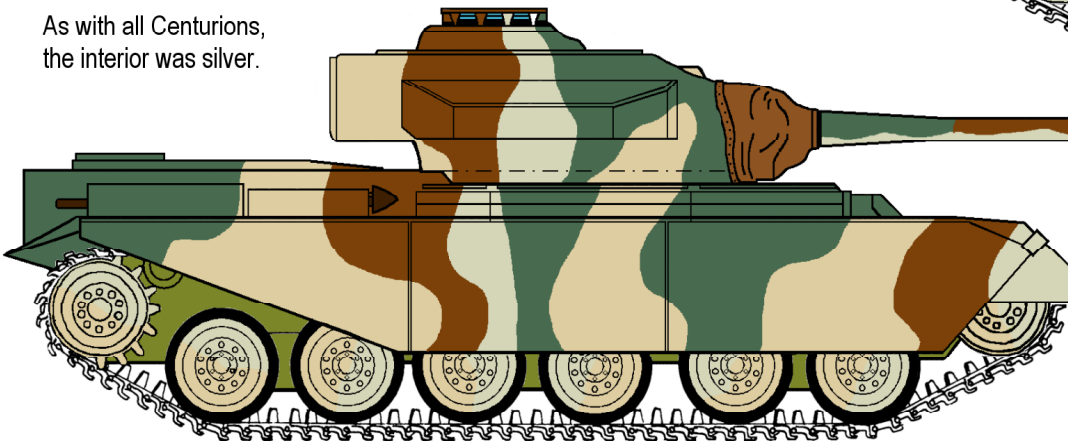


# Canadian Centurion Mk.3 to 11 - Four Colour Pattern

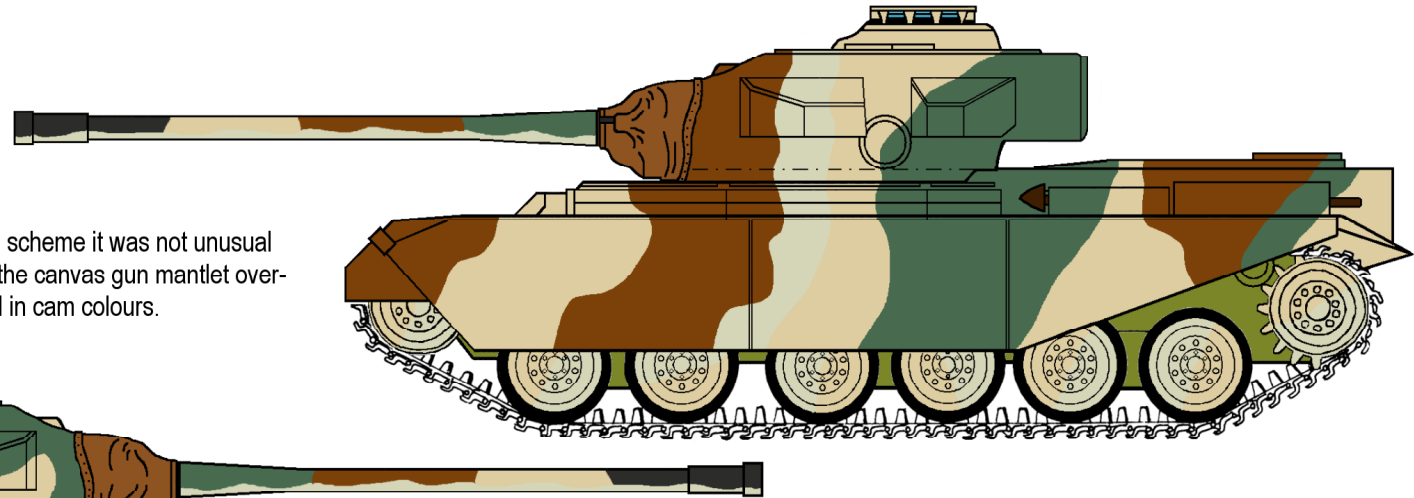


As with all Centurions, the interior was silver.

On this scheme it was not unusual to find the canvas gun mantlet over-painted in cam colours.



This camouflage scheme was applied to Centurions both in Canada and Germany. The earliest I can document its use is 1965 but it is possible that it was used as early as 1962. It disappeared from European service in 1969 when the NATO pattern appeared. It could be seen on all marks with both the 20 Pounder and 105mm guns. When on the 105mm vehicles the upper tube black portion seems to have been applied over the fume extractor rather than at the end as seen here.
