

Subj: Contingent Transfer to the Standby Reserve

- (1) Are completing your military obligation;
- (2) Are completing twenty years for retirement purposes under the provisions of Title 10, United States Code 1006;
- (3) Were screened from the Ready Reserve as being a Key Federal Employee, or;
- (4) Were temporarily assigned to the Standby Reserve Active for hardship or other cogent reason with the expectation of being returned to the Ready Reserve.
