## Laborers in Deir Al Balah Governorate

## 1. Population of Deir Al Balah Governorate.

The number of population of Deir Al Balah Governorate was (24644) people of both sexes, thereof (22387) males and (22257) females. It was observed that the hired employed workers were the most numerous than the other categories as the males amounted to (18177) and the females were (2124).

Regarding ages, those between (25-44) years old, were the majority among both sexes as the males numbered (13626) and the females were (1546).

According to the main occupation, those, working in primary careers were the most amounting to (6839) males. In female category, the female technicians and the specialist assistants were the most, amounting in number to (1132), about (50\%) of the working females.

Those, working in general administration, defense and the compulsory social insurance, as one of the economical activities, were the majority in male category amounting in number to (5418), about ( $24 \%$ ) of the working males over ten years of age. Whereas in females, those working in education were the majority, as their number amounted to (1201), about (53\%) of the total females.

## 2. Employed Over 10 Years Population in Deir Al Balah Governorate.

The grand total of this category was (20984) people, thereof (18877) males, and (2107) females. Those, working in general administration, defense and the social insurance, were the majority in male category as their number amounted to (5225), about ( $28 \%$ ) of the total males. In female category, those, working in education, were the majority, amounting in number to (1109), about (53\%) of the total females.

As for work status, those hired employed workers, were the majority in male category, as they numbered (15194), about ( $80 \%$ ) of the total-working males.

Whereas hired employed females, were the majority, as their number amounted to (1988), about (94\%) of the total working females.

As for age, the workers between (30-34) years old were the majority in male category in Deir Al Balah Governorate as their number amounted to (3841), about (20\%) of the total males. In female category, the workers between (25-29) years old, were the majority, numbering (480), about (23\%) of the total-working females.

## 3. Unemployed Over 10 Years Population.

The grand total of this category was about (8049) people, thereof (7347) males and (702) females. Those between (25-44) years old, were the majority in both sexes as their number in male category was (2894), about (39\%) of the total males, and their number in females was (298), about (425) of the total females.

Regarding years of study, those who finished between (10-12) years of study, were the majority in male category, as their number amounted to (2068), about ( $28 \%$ ) of the total males, whereas the females who studied (13+) years, were the majority, amounting in number to (381) about (54\%) of the total females.

## 4. Already-Employed Over 10 Years Jobless Population.

The grand total of this category amounted to (3660) people, thereof (3510) males and (150) females, as the hired employed workers were the majority in male category amounting to (2983) about ( $85 \%$ ) of the total males and the hired female workers were the majority amounting to (136) about ( $91 \%$ ) of the total females.

Regarding age, those between (25-44) years old, were the majority in both sexes as the male number amounted to (1924), about (55\%) in female category as their number was (97), about (65\%).

## 5. Palestinian Heads of families Over 15 Years employed and Already-Employed Jobless in Deir Al Balah Governorate.

The total number of this category amounted to (15982) thereof (15842) males and (140) females as those working in constructions were the majority in male category as their number amounted to (3546), about $22 \%$ of the total males. In females, those who worked in education were the majority amounting in number to (65), about (46\%) of the total females.

As for work status of the family heads, the hired employed workers were the majority in male category amounting in number to (12766), about (80\%). In female category their number amounted to 9114 ) about ( $81 \%$ ).
