This fonds is made up of of two parts, the first is from the European Payments Union, which previously comprised part of the OEEC fonds, where it was listed as the "Travers' Archive", as a lot of the records were accumulated by Harry Travers, a member of the OEEC Secretariat assigned to EPU activity. Travers started as an Administrator with the Payments Division of the Trade and Payments Division, the EPU. The records consist of minutes of the Managing Board of the EPU, annual reports, reports by the Agent (BIS), EPU agreements and renewals. OEEC internal memoranda and exchanges of letters with delegations. The second part of this fonds consists of material from the EMA, the successor to the EPU.

The European Pyaments Union set out to provide an automatic mechanism for the settlement of net surpluses and deficits of OEEC member countries by gold payments and credit, granted through a central agency. The BFIS (Bank of International Settlements) in Basle, acted as agent for the OEEC in respect of the EPU operations, expressing Member countries credits and deficits with each other in a single credit or deficit balance with the EPU each month. As a key component of the OEEC, the EPU was both an instrument of Europe's economic recovery and integration, and an important factor in its transition from bilateralism to currency convertibility. The EPU provided the basis which enabled all the western European currencies to be transferable into one another, thereby enhancing the OEEC's efforts in liberalising intra-European trade from quantitative restrictions and discriminatory regulations. The successor to this initiative was signed in 1955 and came into force in 1959 following the termination of the EPU. The Agreement provided a framework for monetary co-operation in Europe during the period of transition to full convertibility of currencies. Furthermore the EMA acted as a multilateral mechanism for an exchange guarantee on central banks holdings of member country currencies.

The European Monetary Agreement (EMA) was established by the Council of the OEEC on 29th July 1955 and was signed by all Member countries of the OEEC, it only came into force in 1959 as the successor of the European Payments Union (EPU), which by majority decision of its member countries was terminated at the end of 1958. When the OECD replaced the OEEC in September 1961, the Agreement continued in force between all the 18 Member countries of the OEEC, but the two additional Members under the OECD, the US and Canada did not become members. The EMA was designed to foster two of the basic aims of the OEEC: the achievement and maintenance of fully multilateral trade and the general convertibility of currencies. It provided an institutional framework for continuing monetary co-operation and mutual consultation, which had been established under the European Payments Union. This institution was the European Fund, whose principal function was to grant non-automatic short-term credit to Member countries who applied for credit, so as to overcome balance of payments difficulties that could hamper their intra-European liberalisation measures. The Multilateral System of Settlements facilitated the settlement of transactions made in the currencies and between the Monetary areas of Member countries effectively each Member's Central Bank was assured of obtaining settlement in dollars at an exchange rate known in advance, of its holdings in other Member's currencies.

The Board of Management advised the Council on all matters concerning the Agreement and it had the power to make decisions on certain key issues. It kept the economic and financial situation of the member countries under review as well as the development of the foreign exchange and the international capital market.

The European Fund provided short-term credit to member countries which needed it to enable them to withstand balance of payment difficulties. Credits were granted by the Fund in gold and had to be repaid within two years. Its initial capital provided for by the

EMA was 607 million dollars. The credits were granted after agreement had been reached on the measures required to restore the internal and external equilibrium of the country concerned, which undertook to carry out these measures and to reinforce them, as necessary, in consultation with the OECD.

The problems of reconstruction and industrial development in post-war Europe provided the climate in which a flexible payments system was necessary. The OEEC took action and established the European Payments Union on 1st July 1950, by an agreement signed by all Members of the OEEC. The aim was to enable Member countries to continue the liberalisation of trade with discrimination. regardless of the buying power of their currencies. The main functions of the EPU were to act as a clearing house for settling all visibile and invisible transactions. The Central Bank of each Member country had to advise the Bank of International Settlements, which acts as Agent for the Organisation, on a monthly basis the balances of its intra- European transactions. The advantage over bilateral trading meant that a country did not have to be concerned with deficits with other countries provided the deficits were offset by surpluses in other areas. A second function of the EPU was the settlement mechanism. This element of the Union dealt with the settlement of the net balances emerging from multilateral clearing. It was agreed that deficit countries be granted some credit from the Union, but should make gold payments on an increasing scale as their deficits rose. On the other hand creditor countries would finance their supluses partly by credits and would receive gold for the balance. The EPU was provided with a working capital fund in gold and dollars as a guarantee for creditors contributed in the main part by the US. The Union was restructured and renewed until it was terminated at the end of 1958. It was not conceived of a as a permanent body, its aim was to return to fully multilateral trade and the general convertibility of currencies, its successor the EMA, provided the two necessary institutions to complete this task, the European Fund and a Multilateral System of Settlements.
