How to use Meetup.com to participate in your Townhall conservative group






- 1. Visit <a href="http://townhall.meetup.com">http://townhall.meetup.com</a>
- Enter your ZIP code and click "Go"






3. Choose from the list of Townhall Meetup groups near you (Note: You are able to sign up for multiple groups, and you may want to look through a few of the groups to get a feel for their members and activities.)






4. Once you have chosen a group, click the "Sign up now" button on the group's main page





5. Create your Meetup account by entering the required information





6. An message will be sent to you that prompts you to verify your email address:


You can verify your account in one of three ways:

- (1) Click on the link in the email sent to you by Meetup.com
- (2) Copy and paste the link into the address bar of Internet Explorer
- (3) Reply to the verification email sent to you.

If you have any problems with the verification process, email <a href="mailto:support@meetup.com">support@meetup.com</a> and let them know that you're having problems.




Once you sign in to the Meetup.com system as a new user, you will be prompted to enter additional (optional) information about yourself that will be displayed in the "Members" section.



### **Townhall Meetup events**




Each month, National Townhall Meetups happen on the first Tuesday at 7:00 p.m. However, your organizer may choose to add additional events to the group's calendar. To view all of your group's events, click on the "Events" link in the left toolbox.



### **RSVP** for your Townhall Meetup




Once you have found your Townhall Meetup group's events page, click on the "RSVP" link at the right of each listed event to let the organizer know whether you plan to attend or not.



# **RSVP for your Townhall Meetup**




Enter whether you will attend, how many guests you plan to bring, and any comments that you may have, then click "Submit."



#### **Contact other members**




Only Meetup+ members have the ability to contact other members. To contact other members, click on the "Members" link in the toolbox at the left.



#### **Contact other members**




Find the member's name in the membership list, and click on the envelope next to their name. (*Note: If there is a red "X" through the envelope, you are not able to contact that member.*)



#### **Contact other members**




If you are not yet a Meetup+ member, you will be prompted to join, giving you additional features for a fee.



# Use Townhall Meetup message boards



Each Townhall Meetup group has a message board for members to communicate in between Meetups. To access these message boards, click on the "Message Board" link in the toolbox on the left.




# Use Townhall Meetup message boards

Or you can start your own discussion on a topic of your choice




# Use Townhall Meetup message boards




To reply to a discussion, click "Add a reply."

To receive a weekly email summary on any discussion updates, click "Track this discussion."






To upload digital or scanned photos that were taken of your Meetup group, click on "Photos" in the toolbox on the left.






Click "Add a photo" at the top of the next page, which directs you to the upload page. From there, choose the event at which the photo was taken, click on "Browse" to find the photo on your computer's hard drive, add a caption, then click "Upload Photo" to complete.






To tell others about Townhall Meetups via the web, click on the "Spread the Word" link in the toolbox at the left.





To contact your group's organizer, click on "Contact Organizer," enter a message into the form on the following page, and click "send."
