

A long and tragic history

From the defeat of Imperial France at Sedan in 1870 to the famous German breakthrough in 1940, the Ardennes were the scene of murderous battles in which the very fate of France was often at stake.

These last three wars, those of 1870, 1914-18 and 1939-45, are the subject of this new museum devoted to the themes of war and peace in the Ardennes. Situated in the very heart of the Ardennes, this new amenity traces the salient events in the history of the Ardennes and places them in their historical and military context.

Grandiose reconstructions

Housed in a superb building with 4000 m2 of floor space, the museum is set out in two vast exhibition areas. On the ground floor are ten reconstructions featuring some 40 items of military hardware and 80 figures and depicting various episodes in the three conflicts.

Each reconstruction uses original sets brought to life with sound, light and images and is accompanied by a short film highlighting both the historical context and the particular situation in the Ardennes.

Visitors can go through the museum at their own pace thanks to the audio guides, available in French, Dutch, English and German.

Fully refitted in 2003, the museum features an 1800 m2 reception building on piles including an exhibition of equipment and machines. It also includes seven museum rooms, making it possible to discover changes in forestry management over the years and a presentation including models of the Ardennes forest along with its history, its myths and its legends and its economic activities. The outdoor forestry trail includes 31 stopping points with audio narration lasting 50 minutes. Bar service, terrace and souvenir shop on site... In the forest!



LA HORGNE (08430)

MUSEE DES SPAHIS (The Spahi Museum) Place des Spahis Tel: + 33.(0)3.24.35.64.44

On 15th May, 1940 at the Battle of la Horgne 700 Spahi Cavalry fought for five hours against German tanks leading to the loss of 600 lives.

The Spahi Museum includes paintings, drawings and a huge collection of items recovered at La Horgne related to the Spahis. Price (adult) from $1.50 \in$ per person Price (child): free (up to 12 years of age)

The "Musée Mai-Juin 40" (May - June 1940 Museum) has been open since the summer of 1999. Just a few kilometres from the Maginot Line, it provides a snapshot of the lives of French and German soldiers during the fighting in the Ardennes.

An extensive private collection is presented, including uniforms, weapons, munitions, military equipment, posters, documents from the period and items recovered from the battlefields as well as souvenirs of the evacuation, flags, etc.

ROCROI (08230)

MUSEE DE LA BATAILLE DE ROCROY (The Battle of Rocroi Museum) 16TH-17TH CENTURY FORTIFICA-TIONS

Located in a former 17th century guardroom, the BATTLE OF ROCROI MUSEUM tells the story of one of the most important periods in the history of France. In the middle of the Thirty Years' War which tore Europe apart between 1618 and 1648, here at the foot of the walls of Rocroi on May 19th 1643 Condé successfully halted an attempted Spanish invasion, in the process starting the reign of the Sun King in spectacular fashion. This 20 minute presentation explains the political situation in 1643, the movements of the armies and the manoeuvring of the regiments during the battle. Rocroi was a "highspeed battle" involving six hours of combat, 50,000 men and 10,000 dead.

Unique of its kind in France, the STAR-SHA-PED FORTIFICATIONS OF ROCROI alone are worth the visit!

The King of France Henri II, built a fortified stronghold here in 1555 to face Charlemont. In 1675 this was modified by VAUBAN who retained the star-shaped layout. In 1643, Rocroi was the scene of a battle won by Le Grand Condé over the Spanish. The museum tracing the history of this battle is located in a former guardroom built under Vauban. The "Museum of the Battle of May - June 1940" is located on the Ardennes canal, the epicentre of the intensive fighting which took place during the month of June 1940. The collections represent a large sample of items including uniforms, hats, equipment and weapons from both sides (including motorcycles, a German DCA, dummies, artillery, etc.).

On 13th May, 1940, German troops invaded France once again, passing via Sedan.

The curator of the museum has sought to restore the image of the French army of 1940 through the many heroic acts and sacrifices of the soldiers in various parts of the Ardennes including Stonne, La Horgne, Voncq, etc.


On May 18th 1940, beginning at 6pm the Germans launched an attack on the fortifications at la Ferté, succeeding in destroying the firing slits as well as bringing down the turret and introducing demolition charges. Altogether, 104 French soldiers died on 19th May 1940. This is an impressive visit which will take you 35 metres underground to discover the life of a soldier in a fortress of the Maginot line.

GIVET (08600) FORT DE CHARLEMONT (16th – 17th century) Tel + 33 (0)3.24.42.03.54 Fax + 33 (0)3.24.40 10 70

Sensing a threat from the kingdom of France, in 1555 Charles Quint gave the order to build an impenetrable fortress on the limestone spur of Givet which today bears his name: Charlemont. The fortress became French in 1678. It was enlarged and equipped with a new outer wall in 1680 by Vauban. Open in July and August only.

MONTCORNET EN ARDENNE (08090)

Medieval fortress built on a rocky spur, Montcornet (the horned hill) was rebuilt and enlarged in the 15th century by the famous Antoine de Croy, the first chamberlain of the Duke of Burgundy. The fortress was dismantled in 1760. The underground chambers of the chateau today house a museum introducing various everyday items found during the clearance of the chateau site.

RUMIGNY (08290)

MAISON FORTE DE LA COUR DES PRES (16th – 18th century fortified mansion) Tel: + 33 (0)3.24.35.52.66

The Cour des Prés is a former fortified mansion built in 1546 by Louis Martin, the Provost of Rumigny in response to a request from François 1st who wanted to fortify the region in order to offer better protection for the population against the invasions of Charles Quint. Often passed on through the female side of the family, this residence has remained in the same family since it was built. Today, Monsieur Avril is pleased to introduce you to the history of her home and help you to appreciate its unique charm. Musical evenings at the Chateau in July and August.

At the edge of the forest lies the manoir abbatial d'Elan (Elan Abbey Manor), early 16th century, flanked by four towers. Opposite the manor house, the former monks' dwelling (16th century) is now home to a barn.

Nearby, the manse abbatiale offers visitors a photographic exhibition as well as models of the Elan Abbey, the Cistercian abbeys in France, the main Cistercian sites in France and the characteristics of the various parts which make up the abbey (the cloister, the chapter house, the dormitory, the church, etc).

Local produce for sale throughout the year.

To complete your visit, enjoy an unguided stroll around the Chapel of Saint Roger. St Roger, a monk from the shores of England, was given the task of setting up the Elan Abbey in 1148 by the Count of Rethel. At the end of his life, he withdrew to this site where he meditated, accomplishing numerous miracles of which the last was to make the water from this spring so icy cold that it could even cure the fires of love.

He died here on January 4th 1175. The chapel, built in the early 18th century, celebrates his memory.




MOUZON (08210)

ABBATIALE NOTRE-DAME (12th -15th century abbey church) Tel: + 33 (0)3.24.26.56.11 + 33 (0)3.24.26.10.63 Fax: + 33 (0)3.24.26.27 73

Gothic style Abbey Church from the 13th century. The choir dates from the late 12th century, and the nave was built following a fire in 1212 which raged through Mouzon, the towers dating from the 15th century. The organs (1725) are by C. Moucherel (the organ case being listed in the additional inventory of historical monuments). Don't miss the nearby 17th-century abbey (currently a retirement home) and its French style gardens.

NEUVILLE-DAY (08130) PRIEURE DE DAY (17th – 18th century priory) Tel: + 33 (0)3.24.71.42.37

Purchased on December 2nd 1622 by Dom Etienne d'Auvergne, the great prior of the charterhouse, it was destroyed around 1656 and rebuilt in the late 17th and early 18th century.

Impressive three-storey medieval cellars. Mont-Dieu charterhouse cellar from 1622 to 1792.


MUSEE DE L'ARDENNE (The Ardennes Museum) 31 place Ducale Tel: + 33.(0)3.24.32.44.60

Located in the historic heart of the 17th century town, The Ardenne Museum included 3400m2 of exhibition rooms in a building of outstanding architectural quality (17th, 18th centuries together with contemporary architecture).

The choice of collections on display has been carefully selected based on a wish to show the strong personality of the Ardennes region. The archeological collections, the raised maps of Charleville and Mézières in the 17th century, the Pharmacie de l'Hotel Dieu de Charleville (1756) and the numismatic collection (one of the most extensive in France), are all particularly appreciated by the visitor.

Throughout the year the temporary gallery hosts exhibitions, including some devoted to contemporary artists.

CHARLEVILLE MEZIERES (08000) PLACE DUCALE(17th century) Tel: + 33 (0)3.24.55.69.90

One of the finest squares in northern Europe, the Place Ducale was designed in the 17th century by the architect Clément Métézeau. Comprising 24 Louis XIII houses in Dom stone and brick, topped by French-style roofs covered with Fumay slate, it is interspersed with four "half-houses" featuring imperial-style domes. These are the tallest houses in the town. Take time to enjoy a stroll among the gallery of archways around these houses.

CHARLEVILLE MEZIERES (08000) GRAND MARIONNETTISTE (20th century) (The Great Puppeteer) Tel: + 33 (0)3.24.55.69.90

Since 1991 in Place Winston Churchill the time of day has been elegantly chimed out by the "Grand Marionnettiste" clock. Built into the facade of the Institut de la Marionnette (puppetry institute), this amazing giant automatic clock produced by Jacques Monestier plays out an episode from the legend of the Quatre Fils Aymon (a tragic medieval saga related to the history of the Ardennes) every hour from 10am to 9pm. The 12 scenes are shown as a single performance every Saturday at 9.15pm.

CHARLEVILLE MEZIERES (08000) BASILIQUE NOTRE-DAME DE L'ESPERANCE (15th – 17th century basilica) Tel: + 33 (0)3.24.57.50.62 + 33 (0)3.24.57.53.92 Fax: +33 (0)3.24.37.12.02

This flamboyant Gothic style basilica also includes Renaissance style sections. Superb contemporary stained-glass windows by René Dürrbach.

In 1570, King Charles IX married Elizabeth, the daughter of the Emperor of Austria here.

With an area of 35,000 m2, Sedan Castle is the largest medieval castle in the whole of Europe.

In a strategically important position on France's eastern frontier, it was continually extended, strengthened and modernised by the powerful La Marcks, dukes of Bouillon and sovereign princes of Sedan.

The Castle is now a listed historic monument and tells its own story by means of the Historium, a tour made up of various scenographic reconstructions depicting in the most minute detail the lives of ordinary people and soldiers under the Principality. In the company of our guide, you will embark on a discovery tour of this fortress which has for around six centuries stood in the heart of the town of Sedan.

The castle's museum houses a host of treasures including numerous tapestries (Aubusson, Beauvais, Brussels), military paintings depicting the war of 1870 and several artefacts unearthed during successive excavations in the castle.

Situated in the heart of the legendary forest, Bogny sur Meuse invites you to discover the fascinating world of the Ardennes metal industry. Here, like elsewhere throughout the French Ardennes the men of the forest worked iron with devotion and passion!

You can discover the workshop of the nail maker, his forge and his wooden wheel where the "flea engine" would run (in other words... a dog!). You can also discover anvil blocks, as well as nuts and bolts in every conceivable shape and size. In addition to technical documents, the works of the great writers and painters combine with an outstanding collection of illustrations and features to vividly portray the extraordinary industrial heritage of the French Ardennes.

Located to the south of Sedan, the Musée des Débuts de l'Aviation (Early Aviation Museum) presents a biplane by Roger Sommer (1910), four scale models (1908 – 1912) as well as a large number of documents, photos, postcards and video films. Discover the life of car racer and manufacturer Roger Sommer, as well as of Raymond Sommer, car racer who died during a race in 1950.

The "Relais de Poste aux Chevaux de Launois" (Launois horse post station) is a quadrilateral shaped architectural site with the postmaster's residence flanked by two cart gates and the watchman's lodge, an inner courtyard surrounded by a huge hall with outbuildings (constituting a genuine work of art from the Ardennes master carpenters), a series of stables topped with grain stores and haylofts, in addition to a typical sheepfold.

Created in 1990 by the local council, keen to preserve the area's heritage, the Ecomusée du Linge de Montcy-Notre-Dame or "Linen Museum of Montcy-Notre-Dame" (formerly Montcy-les-Linges) looks back at the collective life of the people of Montcy stretching back a century and a half.

In a traditional setting, it presents the changes over the years in the washing, ironing and production of linen.



The visitor will discover the life and work of Rimbaud, chiefly through the representation of objects, photographic reproductions and copies of various manuscripts, drawings or caricatures portraying Rimbaud or those close to him.

The museum is seeking to boost its collections with all the works devoted to this poet and to add to its collection of original documents.

The museum enables each and everyone to discover the early years of the poet in Charleville, his childhood and school years, the letters to his teacher Izambard, his first contact with the literary world and with Paul Verlaine, his "escapes", his travels and his life in Abyssinia.

Charleville Mézières pays tribute to its most famous son, Arthur Rimbaud, born here in 1854. Visitors can discover Rue Pierre Bérégovoy and Quai Arthur Rimbaud, the two houses where Rimbaud lived from his birth to his teenage years.

After many adventures which led to him discovering Europe, Cyprus and Africa, Rimbaud died in Marseilles in 1891 at the age of 37. His body today lies in Charleville cemetery in a white marble tomb.

Charleville-Mézières has celebrated in 2004 the 150th anniversary of the birth of the poet.

The house is located at No. 7 on the quay bearing the name of the poet, and Vitalie Rimbaud and her children lived there from 1869 to 1875. The Rimbauds occupied the 130m2 of the first floor. The City later acquired the entire building, and chose to adorn each room with elements of decoration representing cities the poet and adventurer had visited: Harare, London, Stuttgart, Aden, Brussels, Roche, Paris...

To better convey the "elsewhere" the poet sought throughout his life, each room is to be equipped with a discreet sound system to emit words, music and sounds for all to hear. Images will also be projected, upon windows of the home forming screens, and these will recall the poet's travels. Additionally, one specific colour is to be produced by several different light sources, and this will be visible from outside the house.

An exact replication of the original position of furniture was not the desired effect: the house was left as it was found. The goal is to take visitors along a "journey" of light, poetry, and music, awakening their imagination and allowing them to recreate the world of Rimbaud in a truly personal way. The reading room, located on the ground floor, contains hundreds of works in several languages.
