


Methodology


Direction of the Country




Do you feel things in this country are generally going in the right direction, or do you think things are seriously off on the wrong track?


Most Important Issue Facing the U.S. Today

Public Figures and Institutions: Favorability








And do you approve or disapprove of the way George W. Bush is handling...?




Required Changes to the Social Security System








Should legal immigration into the united States be kept at its present level, increased or decreased?



US Immigration Levels: By Party ID





US Immigration Levels: By Income
























Presidential Election: 2008 Candidates Named




