Neighborhood information at a glance...

- Population growth in Westmount is generally down. Compared to other neighborhoods in London, Westmount is among the top ten most populated planning districts.
- The age distribution in Westmount is slightly older than London as a whole. Specifically, of the total population of Westmount:
 - 4.3% of residents (n=705) are children age 0-4 years and 6.3% (n=1,030) are age 5-9 years.
 - 7% of residents (n=1,135) are youth age 10-14 years and 8.1% (n=1,310) are age 15-19.
 - 12.7% of residents (n=2,060) are age 20-29 years and 11.8% (n=1,920) adults age 30-39.
 - 15.1% of residents (n=2,450) are age 40-49 and 8.6% (n=1,400) are age 50-54.
 - 11.4% of residents (n=1,850) are seniors age 55-64 years and 14.7% (n=2,395) are 65 years and older.
- The top five ethnic origins of residents of Westmount are: English, Scottish, Canadian, Irish and German.
- The top five languages spoken by residents of Westmount are: English, Spanish, Arabic, Serbo-Croatian, and Polish.
- Employment among residents of Westmount is down slightly and lower than London as a whole.
 The top occupations of Westmount residents are: Sales and Service Occupations; Business,
 Finance, and Administration; Management Occupations; Occupations in Social Sciences,
 Education, and Government; and Trades, Transport, and Equipment Operators and related
 Occupations.
- Home ownership in Westmount is down and slightly lower than London with approximately 6 out of every 10 private dwellings owned.
- The average rent in Westmount is \$698. This is higher than the average rent in other London neighborhoods. (The average rent for London was \$648).
