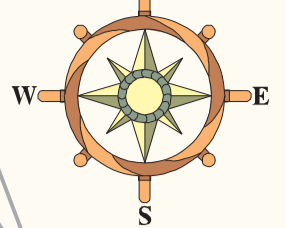
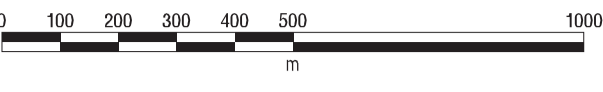


MAP OF Port Jackson western area, Lower Parramatta and Lane Cove Rivers.

Caution: Lane Cove River can be Shallow in places at Low Tide.

Note: A number of public moorings are situated throughout the Harbour. Pink in colour, they are only available for 24 hours for ONE vessel at any time. Buoys marked Police and coloured blue are emergency purposes only.

Note: Some launching ramps shown have limited access and parking facilities. Larger public facilities may incur parking charges.

Caution: Rowers use these waterways. Avoid creating unnecessary wash.

Caution: Seagrass Areas shown on this map are easily damaged by boat propellers and anchors. Please navigate with caution across these areas and avoid anchoring in them unless in an emergency.

SECURITY WARNING: Waterside Restricted Security Zones exist at key sites within Sydney Port. Masters are to keep well clear of these areas and vessels moored thereat. Penalties apply for unauthorised entry.

Note: Orange areas indicate Waterside Restricted Zones at Maritime Security Level 1, when a vessel is at berth. Gore Cove operates at all times. Restricted Zones will vary at increased security levels.
