This district has three big valleys: Shibi dara (12 small villages which is the most populated valley), Masken dara (15 villages), Allah Saiy dara(21 villages).

The district office is lactated in Allah Saiy village but the building is destroyed. People are speaking in differed languages like Dari, Pashtoo and Pashaee. District has no office; the officials use the school building as an office.
