The Danish Pork and Bacon Industry

Background Information

Denmark has a long tradition of pig production, and its pork and bacon industry has acquired an international reputation for excellence, in particular for its high standards of product quality, safety and farm management.

Records suggest that Denmark began exporting bacon to the U.K. in 1847 over 150 years ago. The modern Danish pig industry comprises some 11,000 pig producers, the vast majority of whom still work in family-run enterprises. Around 1.75 million tonnes of pigmeat are exported to markets all over the world

Most Danish pigmeat is produced in co-operative factories, owned by the pig producers themselves. Today, two large co-operative groups slaughter around 22 million pigs per year. The close commercial link between the Danish pig producers and their factories means that there is a very clear understanding of the requirement to produce a high quality product for today's discerning consumer.

The Danish industry is highly structured and integrated so that agreed changes can be swiftly implemented in any part of the production chain. Danske Slagterier, known as DS, is the organisation which represents the interests of all Danish pig producers, and their co-operative factories and processing units.

DS is funded by the Danish pig producers through a statutory levy and a subscription from its member companies. This produces an annual turnover of around DKK 352m (£32.5m approx.) which helps fund a wide variety of pig industry projects and initiatives.

Much of DS's research work concerns primary pig production which includes pig breeding and producer advisory services. In co-operation with the National Committee for Pig Production, (Landsudvalget for Svin), DS funds a major programme of research into all aspects of pig production, totalling DKK 89m (£8.2m approx.).

Other research and development work is carried out at the Danish Meat Research Institute. DS is also responsible for co-ordinating a number of quality initiatives, such as the Danish Quality Guarantee and the Contract for UK production, and a national programme for control of salmonella.

DS also has a vital role in representing the industry's interests in the area of trade policy both in Denmark, the EU and many overseas markets. The organisation also has a responsibility for co-ordinating a series of marketing and promotional campaigns both in Denmark itself and in key export markets such as the UK.

Danish Bacon has received consistent advertising and promotional support since the 1950s. The advertising originally focused on the well known Danish stripmark and on the well known slogan "Good Bacon has Danish written all over it" which was first used at that time.

This mark was stamped on all Danish bacon sides shipped to the UK and allowed consumers to clearly identify Danish bacon at point of sale. More recently the advertising has also featured the famous Danish bacon "sizzle". Over 90% of housewives spontaneously associate this symbol with Danish bacon.

The long-running programme of marketing support has given Danish bacon the status of a brand in the UK market. In recent research, over a quarter of consumers said that Danish was their preferred bacon.






1.4 Danish Pigmeat Exports by Destination 2004 value

2.2 EU Pigmeat Consumption (Kg per head per annum)





3.2 Country Share of UK Bacon Supplies









4.4 Bacon: Preference for Country's Bacon (First Mention)





4.5 Bacon: Impulse Purchase





4.6 Bacon: Product Shares (Volume)






4.8 Bacon Rashers: By Type (Volume Shares)



5.1 Bacon Rashers: Use by Meal Occasion





5.3 Bacon Steaks: Use by Meal Occasion



6.1 Meat Safety


"Would you consider that the question of safety applied when eating any of these foods on this list or not?" (%)

Pigmeat accounts for over a third of total agricultural output from Denmark.

Average farm size in Denmark is 55 hectares, second largest in EU after the UK.

Farm productivity has increased on average by 3% per annum over the last 30 years.

Nearly all Danish farms are owner occupied.
