Central Park (under construction)

Located south of the Point Bridge in Grand Forks. From DeMers Avenue, follow South 4th Street to the park.

Currently under construction, when completed Central Park will be a welcome addition to the Greenway.

Community Green/Rotary Park

Located in downtown Grand Forks on DeMers Avenue, north on Riverboat Road.

The Community Green/Rotary Park area is located in the heart of downtown Grand Forks. This scenic area offers the natural beauty of the Red River just a stones throw away from the hustle and bustle of downtown Grand Forks and East Grand Forks.

Features:

- Gazebo (Approximately 10'4" x 11'4" inside)
- Drinking fountain
- Recreational trails
- Bike racks
- Trash receptacles
- Obelisk with flood elevation levels
- Informational kiosks; to place information in the kiosk call 701-787-3756
- Benches
- Large parking lot at the end of the road

Other Amenities:

- Located just west of Town Square in downtown Grand Forks
- 8 decorative lights with festoon receptacles (120v, 15-20 amp service)
- Banner arms for hanging banners
- Restrooms are located in Town Square

★ Please note: There are removable bollards along the trails.

Crestwood Trail

Located on the Point in East Grand Forks. Take US Highway 220 south over the Louis Murray Bridge, turn left on 4th St. SE, turn left again on next road.

Please note: Reservations for the shelters and warming house can be made through East Grand Forks Parks and Recreation at (218) 773-8000 or 600 DeMers Avenue, East Grand Forks. Reservation fees may be required.

Eagle Point Trail Head-RRSRA

Located in East Grand Forks on 3rd Avenue between the Murray and Point Bridges.

Please note: Reservations for the shelters and warming house can be made through the East Grand Forks Parks and Recreation at (218) 773-8000 or 600 DeMers Avenue, East Grand Forks. Reservation fees may be required.

Located near the fork of the Red and Red Lake Rivers, Eagle Point Trail Head offers visitors plenty of amenities and views of the two rivers. A rock dam located below the scenic overlook provides excellent shore bank fishing.

One large picnic shelter 20' x 34'

- One 20-amp power receptacle
- 30-40 person capacity
- 3 four-person stationary picnic tables
- 3 grills
- Trash receptacles
- 7' of concrete clearance around shelter for persons with disabilities

Griggs Park Trail Head

Located south of downtown East Grand Forks. Take Highway 2, then south on Central Avenue, turn right on Hill Street, two blocks.

Please note: Reservations for the Shelters and warming house can be made through East Grand Forks Parks and Recreation at (218) 773-8000 or 600 DeMers Avenue, East Grand Forks. Reservations fees may be required.

One large shelter 40 x 20 ft

- 20 amp service
- 10 picnic tables
- 7 grills
- Trash receptacles

Lincoln Drive Park

Located in Grand Forks. From South Washington Street, turn east on 13th Avenue South, which leads directly to Lincoln Drive Park.

Please note: Reservations for the Shelters and warming house can be made through the Grand Forks Park District Office (701) 746-2750 or 1210 7th Avenue South, Grand Forks, ND. Reservation fees may be required.

Two large picnic shelters 60' x 40'

- One 50-amp power receptacle and one 20-amp power receptacle
- 70 person capacity each
- 1 grill
- Trash receptacles
- 5' of paved clearance around the shelter for persons with disabilities

Two small picnic shelters 30' x 46'

- One 20-amp power receptacle in each
- 30 person capacity each
- 5' of paved clearance around the shelter for persons with disabilities
- Trash receptacles

Warming House 57'4" x 28'

- Electricity
- Restrooms
- Counter area with sink

Features

- Large Parking Lot with over 100 stalls

 - 18 hole disc golf course
 - Sledding hill (seasonal)

Lincoln Park Golf Course Trail Head

Located in Grand Forks. From South Washington Street, turn east on 13th Avenue South, south on Belmont Road, east on Elks Drive which leads to the club house.

Features:

- Clubhouse & Restroom
 - Recreational trail
 - Basketball courts
 - Tennis courts
 - 9 hole golf course

River Heights Trail Head - RRSRA

Located in East Grand Forks just two blocks north of US Highway 2 on 4th Street NW.

Please note: Reservations for the shelters and warming house can be made through the Red River State Recreation Area office at (218) 773-4950 or 515 2nd Street NW, East Grand Forks. Reservation fees are required.

Site A

- One large picnic shelter 35' x 50'
- One 20-amp receptacles
- 40 person capacity
- 4 four-person stationary picnic tables at this site
- 2 grills

- 5' of concrete around the shelter for persons with disabilities

Riverside Park (under construction)

Located in Grand Forks off US Highway 2/Gateway Drive to North 3rd Street; right on Conklin Avenue to 1st Avenue.

Please note: Reservations for the shelters and warming house can be made through the Grand Forks Park District Office (701) 746-2750 or 1210 7th Avenue South, Grand Forks, ND. Reservation fees may be required.

Two large picnic shelters 60' x 40', each featuring:

- One 50-amp power receptacle
- One 20-amp power receptacle
- 70 person capacity
- 1 grill
- Trash receptacles
- 5' of paved clearance around shelter for persons with disabilities.

Two small picnic shelters 30' x 46'

- No electrical receptacles
- 30 person capacity
- Trash receptacle
- 5' of paved clearance around the shelter for persons with disabilities

Warming house

- Electricity
- Restrooms
- Sink area with counter top

Features

- Two-thirty stall parking lots - off street parking spaces also available
 - Recreational trails
 - Playground equipment

 - Hockey and pleasure skating rinks (seasonal)

Riverside Rapids (under construction)

Located in Grand Forks, US Highway 2/Gateway Drive to Mill Road, right on Red Dot Place to Alpha Avenue to access rapids.

- Shore bank fishing

- Informational Kiosk

Sherlock Park Trail Head

Located in East Grand Forks on 5th Ave. NW, between US Highway 2 and 4th Street NW.

Please note: Reservations for the shelters and warming house can be made through the East Grand Forks Parks and Recreation at (218) 773-8000 or 600 DeMers Avenue, East Grand Forks. Reservation fees may be required.

- One 30 x 45 shelter with 20 amp breaker
