To: Parties to the Condit Settlement Agreement

As you know, the recently negotiated Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) modifying the Condit Hydroelectric Project Settlement Agreement (Settlement Agreement) does not change the fundamental substance of the Settlement Agreement reached by all the federal, state, tribal and non-governmental licensing Parties in 1999. The MOA simply extends Project operations by two years and increases PacifiCorp's commitment to fund permitting and mitigation costs by \$3,300,000 (1999 dollars).

PacifiCorp has been asked about the implications of the MOA on the schedule contained in Appendix C of the Settlement Agreement. More specifically, while the timeframe for the beginning of project removal is delayed for two years, from October 2006 to October 2008, the time period shown for removal remains estimated at approximately 15 months. Therefore, in accordance with the MOA, removal of the dam and other project structures is anticipated to be completed by December 2009.

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT
MODIFYING THE
CONDIT HYDROELECTRIC PROJECT SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

This Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) modifies the Condit Hydroelectric Project Settlement Agreement (Settlement Agreement) by: (a) replacing each occurrence of the term "2006" in the Settlement Agreement with the term "2008"; (b) replacing each occurrence of the term "\$2,000,000" in the Settlement Agreement with the term "\$5,300,000"; and (c) replacing each occurrence of the term "\$17,150,000" in the Settlement Agreement with the term "\$20,450,000". Except as provided in this paragraph, the Settlement Agreement shall remain unmodified.

This MOA may be executed in counterparts. No party shall be entitled to a presumption against any other party based on the drafting of this MOA.






