## **DRUITT TOWN**

### **Directory entries 1887-1891**

#### **Explanatory Notes:**

Druitt Town was the former name of parts of Strathfield South and Enfield, located south of Liverpool Rd to the north side of Cooks River. It was named for Major George Druitt, a friend of Joshua Judge Josephson, a large land owner in the local district. However, most of the 'suburb' of Druitt Town is actually located on land not owned by Josephson. Rather, it is located on the 'Village of St Ann's' [Father John Joseph Therry's grant fo 1847] and the Redmire Estate [originally granted to James Wilshire in 1808].

For a short time, Druitt Town was listed as a suburb. Following incorporation of Enfield Council in 1889, Druitt Town entries were included in directory entries for Enfield from 1892. This locality, south of Liverpool Road, was generally known as the suburb of Enfield.

References to Druitt Town as a suburb ceased c.1891, particularly when the Druitt Town Public School was renamed Strathfield South Public School. From 1949, the locality was incorporated into Strathfield Council and it is currently known as Strathfield South.
