CITIZENSHIP STATISTICS UNITED KINGDOM 1986

1. Around 45,900 people were granted British citizenship in the United Kingdom in 1986, 7,900 fewer than in 1985. The reduction in 1986 resulted mainly from a temporary disruption in the autumn to the flow of work following the computerisation of some of the administrative procedures. Changes in the number of grants made each year are affected by such factors as the number and type of applications received during the year, the amount of work undertaken on applications which will not be completed until a later year, the proportion of applications concluded without the grant of a certificate of citizenship, staff resources and improvements in working practices. In the years 1982-84 grants averaged 70,000 a year reflecting the large numbers of applications received around the time when the British Nationality Act came into force on 1 January 1983. This compared with around 25,000 grants a year between 1977 and 1980.

2. Residence in the United Kingdom continued to be the most common basis on which people were granted British citizenship, either on the basis of an entitlement or at the Home Secretary's discretion, with 23,300 grants in 1986 accounting for over half the total. A further 12,700 grants were on the basis of the applicant's marriage to a British citizen, either by virtue of the entitlement to citizenship, still open to women who were married before 1983 and remain married to a man who then became a British citizen when the British Nationality Act 1981 came into force, or by the exercise of discretion to naturalise a person (male or female) who has lived in the United Kingdom for

three years and whose spouse is a British citizen. 9,400 grants were to minor children, mainly those whose parents were at the same time being, or had already been, granted citizenship.

3. The distribution of grants in 1986 was fairly evenly divided between foreign and Commonwealth citizens. There were falls in grants for most individual nationalities. However, grants to South African nationals increased by 1,000 to 3,300, the majority of which were to minor children or the wives of British citizens with an entitlement to registration. There was also a rise in the number of Jamaican citizens granted citizenship on the basis of an entitlement to registration.

EXPLANATORY NOTES

1. This bulletin gives the following information on grants of citizenship:

(a) a summary of the grants of British and British overseas citizenship and British subject status in the United Kingdom and of British Dependent Territories citizenship granted in the Dependencies, during 1983, 1984, 1985 and 1986 (Table 1);

(b) a summary of the grants of citizenship in the United Kingdom by the main categories for the years 1976-86 (Table 2);

(c) a summary for 1976-86 of the previous nationalities or citizenships of persons granted citizenship in the United Kingdom (Table 3);

(d) a table of grants of British citizenship in the United Kingdom in 1986, analysed by the previous nationality or citizenship and the section of the British Nationality Act 1981 under which citizenship was granted (Table 4).

The figures for BDTC (Gibraltar) and stateless in Table 4 refer to persons registered under sections 5 or 36 respectively of the British Nationality Act 1981.

2. The nationality shown in the first column of Tables 3 and 4 is the one, or in cases of dual nationality the main one, which the person possessed immediately before acquiring British citizenship. As citizens of the Republic of Ireland are treated in the same way as Commonwealth citizens in the naturalisation and registration provisions of the Acts, they have been included in the Commonwealth section of Table 4.

3. The categories shown in Tables 1, 2 and 4 relate to the section of the British Nationality Act 1981 under which citizenship was acquired. The following is a brief summary of the provisions of the relevant sections of the Act:

s.1(3) - entitlement to registration of a minor born in the United Kingdom when one of his parents becomes a British citizen or settled in the United Kingdom.

s.3(1) - discretionary registration of a minor.

s.3(2) - entitlement to registration of a minor less than one year old who was born outside the United Kingdom to parents one of whom was a British citizen by descent.

s.3(5) - entitlement to registration of an overseas-born minor resident in the United Kingdom, one of whose parents was a British citizen by descent.

s.4(2) - entitlement to registration of a British Dependent Territories citizen, a British overseas citizen, a British subject or a British protected person resident in the United Kingdom.

s.4(5) - discretionary registration on the grounds of Crown Service of a British Dependent Territories citizen, a British overseas citizen, a British subject or a British protected person.

s.5 - entitlement to registration of a British Dependent Territories citizen from Gibraltar.

s.6(1) - naturalisation of an adult by virtue of residence in the United Kingdom.

s.6(2) - naturalisation of an adult, resident in the United Kingdom, by virtue of marriage to a British citizen.

s.7 - transitional entitlement to registration of a Commonwealth citizen who would have been entitled to registration under sections 5A(1) or 6(1) of the 1948 Act.

s.8(1) - transitional entitlement to registration of a woman still married since before 1983 to a man who became a British citizen on commencement of the 1981 Act.

s.8(2) and 8(3) - transitional discretionary registration of a woman married before 1983 to a man who would have become a British citizen but for his death or renunciation of citizenship.

s.9 - transitional entitlement to registration of a minor born in a foreign country whose father was or would have been a British citizen.

s.10(1) - entitlement to resume British citizenship by a person previously so entitled.

s.10(2) - discretionary registration of a person connected with the United Kingdom who renounced citizenship of the United Kingdom and Colonies before 1983.

s.13(1) - entitlement to resume British citizenship by a person who renounced it to acquire some other citizenship.

s.36 - entitlement to registration of a stateless person.

Schedule 8 - any applications made before the commencement of the 1981 Act continue to be decided in accordance with the provisions of the previous nationality Acts.

4. Statistics for 1984 and 1985 were published in Statistical Bulletins 21/85 and 26/86. These are available from the Home Office Statistical Department.
