## CITIZENSHIP STATISTICS UNITED KINGDOM 1987

1. Around 64,900 people were granted British citizenship in the United Kingdom in 1987. This was 19,000 more than in 1986, when the numbers were reduced by the work involved in the introduction of computerisation of some of the administrative procedures, and over 11,000 more than in 1985. There were also about 100 grants of British Overseas citizenship in 1987, and around 3,400 grants of citizenship of the British Dependent Territories were recorded in the Dependent Territories. A number of factors contributed to the higher number of grants of British citizenship in 1987 compared with 1985. Those entitled to register as a British citizen formed a higher proportion of all grants than in 1985 and the process of registration is simpler. Computerisation brought gains in increased productivity and there was also a small increase in the staff allocated to the work. On the other hand it was necessary towards the end of the year to divert resources from considering cases and issuing certificates to deal with the very large number of enquiries about citizenship and requests for application forms, many of which required responses before 31 December 1987 when the transitional arrangements, established by the British Nationality Act 1981 for certain classes of people to seek British citizenship as of right, expired. Information on the numbers of applications received in 1987 will be published later this year in the Home Office publication "Immigration, Nationality and Passports".

2. In the years 1982-84 grants averaged 70,000 a year reflecting the large numbers of applications received around the time when the British Nationality Act came into force on 1 January 1983. This compared with around 25,000 grants a year between 1977 and 1980.

3. Residence in the United Kingdom continued to be the most common basis on which people were granted British citizenship, with 38,600 grants in 1987 compared with 23,300 in 1986. Most of this increase was among those granted citizenship on the basis of an entitlement rather than at the Home Secretary's discretion. A further 16,300 grants were on the basis of the applicants' marriage to a British citizen although the rise of 3,600 in such grants in 1987 was largely through an increase in the exercise of discretion to naturalise a person (male or female) who has lived in the United Kingdom for three years or more and whose spouse is a British citizen rather than among women who were married before 1983 and remain married to a man who then became a British citizen when the British Nationality Act 1981 came into force. 9,500 grants, slightly more than in 1986, were to minor children, mainly those whose parents were at the same time being, or had already been, granted citizenship.

4. The increase in grants in 1987 was markedly higher among Commonwealth citizens (up by 14,800 to 38,800) reflecting the ending of the transitional arrangements, than among foreign nationals (up by 3,600 to 23,000). Grants to citizens of the West Indies rose by 12,000 to 22,000 in 1987, with grants to Jamaicans increasing by 9,600 to 16,200, of whom 15,700 were entitled to citizenship on the basis of residence. Amongst foreign nationals, there were proportionately large increases in grants to Iranians (up by 600 to 1,500) and to Vietnamese (up by nearly 400 to 700).

## EXPLANATORY NOTES

1. This bulletin gives the following information on grants of citizenship:
  - (a) a summary of the grants of British and British overseas citizenship and British subject status in the United Kingdom and of British Dependent Territories citizenship granted in the Dependencies, in each of the years 1983-87 (Table 1);
  - (b) a summary of the grants of citizenship in the United Kingdom by the main categories for the years 1977-87 (Table 2);
  - (c) a summary for 1977-87 of the previous nationalities or citizenships of persons granted citizenship in the United Kingdom (Table 3);
  - (d) a table of grants of British citizenship in the United Kingdom in 1987, analysed by the previous nationality or citizenship and the section of the British Nationality Act 1981 under which citizenship was granted (Table 4).

The figures for BDTC (Gibraltar) and stateless in Table 4 refer to persons registered under sections 5 or 36 respectively of the British Nationality Act 1981.

2. The nationality shown in the first column of Tables 3 and 4 is the one, or in cases of dual nationality the main one, which the person possessed immediately before acquiring British citizenship. As citizens of the Republic of Ireland are treated in the same way as Commonwealth citizens in the naturalisation and registration provisions of the Acts, they have been included in the Commonwealth section of Table 4.

3. The categories shown in Tables 1, 2 and 4 relate to the section of the British Nationality Act 1981 under which citizenship was acquired. The following is a brief summary of the provisions of the relevant sections of the Act:

s.1(3) - entitlement to registration of a minor born in the United Kingdom when one of his parents becomes a British citizen or settled in the United Kingdom.

s.3(1) - discretionary registration of a minor.

s.3(2) - entitlement to registration of a minor less than one year old who was born outside the United Kingdom to parents one of whom was a British citizen by descent.

s.3(5) - entitlement to registration of an overseas-born minor resident in the United Kingdom, one of whose parents was a British citizen by descent.

s.4(2) - entitlement to registration of a British Dependent Territories citizen, a British overseas citizen, a British subject or a British protected person resident in the United Kingdom.

s.4(5) - discretionary registration on the grounds of Crown Service of a British Dependent Territories citizen, a British overseas citizen, a British subject or a British protected person.

s.5 - entitlement to registration of a British Dependent Territories citizen from Gibraltar.

s.6(1) - naturalisation of an adult by virtue of residence in the United Kingdom.

s.6(2) - naturalisation of an adult, resident in the United Kingdom, by virtue of marriage to a British citizen.

s.7 - transitional entitlement to registration of a Commonwealth citizen who would have been entitled to registration under sections 5A(1) or 6(1) of the 1948 Act.

s.8(1) - transitional entitlement to registration of a woman still married since before 1983 to a man who became a British citizen on commencement of the 1981 Act.

s.8(2) and 8(3) - transitional discretionary registration of a woman married before 1983 to a man who would have become a British citizen but for his death or renunciation of citizenship.

s.9 - transitional entitlement to registration of a minor born in a foreign country whose father was or would have been a British citizen.

s.10(1) - entitlement to resume British citizenship by a person previously so entitled.

s.10(2) - discretionary registration of a person connected with the United Kingdom who renounced citizenship of the United Kingdom and Colonies before 1983.

s.13(1) - entitlement to resume British citizenship by a person who renounced it to acquire some other citizenship.

s.36 - entitlement to registration of a stateless person.

Schedule 8 - any applications made before the commencement of the 1981 Act continue to be decided in accordance with the provisions of the previous nationality Acts.

4.
